

**SYDNEY SPORTS GROUND AND SYDNEY CRICKET GROUND
AMALGAMATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1958.**

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are:—

- (a) to dedicate certain land for public recreation and to appoint the trustees of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground as trustees of such land ;
- (b) to authorise the trustees of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground to expend trust funds in connection with the re-arrangement of public utility services associated with the area referred to in paragraph (a) above.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The objects of the Bill are to amend the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Act, 1954, in relation to the amalgamation of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground as provided in paragraph (a) of clause 2 of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground (Amendment) Bill, 1958.

A BILL

To provide for the addition of certain land to the area known as the Sydney Sports Ground; for this and other purposes to amend the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation (Amendment) Act, 1958". Short title and citation.

(2) The Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951, as amended by subsequent Acts and by this Act, may be cited as the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951-1958.

2. (1) The Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951, as amended by subsequent Acts, is amended—

(a) by inserting at the end of section two the following new subsection :—

(4) (a) The land described in the Fourth Schedule to this Act is hereby vested in Her Majesty freed and discharged from any trusts, estates, interests, dedications, conditions, restrictions, covenants and provisions affecting such land or any part thereof.

(b) Such land shall be deemed to be Crown land and to be dedicated under the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, for public recreation, and the said Act, as so amended, shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to and in respect of such land.

For the purposes of such application section twenty-six of the said Act, as so amended, shall be read as if the word "eleven" were substituted for the word "seven" wherever occurring in such section.

(c) Such land shall be deemed to be a public reserve within the meaning of section two of the Trustees of Public Reserves Enabling Act, 1924.

(d) The persons who upon the day appointed by the Governor and notified by proclamation published in the Gazette pursuant to subsection three of section two of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation (Amendment) Act, 1958, are trustees of the land described in the Third Schedule to this Act, shall be trustees
