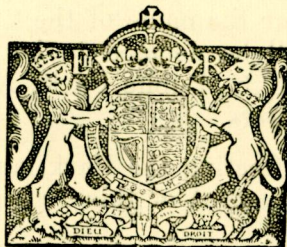

Act No. , 1956.

An Act to dedicate Taronga Zoological Park as a public park; to provide that the existing trustees of that Park shall be deemed to have been appointed under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts; to extend the term of office of Sir Edward Hallstrom as a trustee of that Park; to amend the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, the Public Parks Act, 1912, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Taronga Zoological Park Act, 1956." Short title.

2. (1) The land described in the Schedule to this Act (in this Act referred to as the Park land) is hereby dedicated as a public park under the name of the "Taronga Zoological Park" and shall be deemed to be a public park within the meaning of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts. Dedication of Taronga Zoological Park as a public park under the Public Parks Act, 1912.

(2) Any dedication affecting the Park land immediately before the commencement of this Act is hereby revoked.

3. (1) The persons who immediately before the commencement of this Act held office as trustees of the Park land and were appointed to that office under the provisions of subsection one of section twenty-six of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts (in this Act referred to as the former trustees) shall, as on and from that commencement, cease to hold office as such trustees under that Act as so amended, and be deemed to be trustees of the Park land appointed by the Governor under subsection one of section four of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts. Trustees of Taronga Zoological Park deemed to be trustees under Public Parks Act, 1912.

(2) The corporate name of the body corporate comprised of such lastmentioned trustees and their successors (in this Act referred to as the body corporate) shall be deemed to have been prescribed under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, as the "Trustees of Taronga Zoological Park".

(3) The person who immediately before the commencement of this Act held office as trustee of the Park land and was appointed to that office under the provisions

provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1A) of section twenty-six of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall, as on and from that commencement, cease to hold office as such trustee

- (f) 15 The body corporate may enforce and realise any security or charge existing immediately before that commencement in favour of the former trustees in respect of any such moneys and claims as if such security or charge were existing in favour of the body corporate.
- (g) 20 All debts due and moneys payable by, and all claims, liquidated or unliquidated, recoverable against the former trustees solely relating to the Park land or the trust property or any part thereof shall be debts due and moneys payable by and claims recoverable against the body corporate.
- (h) (i) 25 Every person who immediately before that commencement was a servant of the former trustees in their capacity as trustees of the Park land shall upon that commencement become a servant of the body corporate.
- (ii) 30 The period of service with the former trustees of any person who by virtue of this paragraph becomes a servant of the body corporate shall be deemed to be service with the body corporate for the purposes of annual leave, sick leave or long service leave.

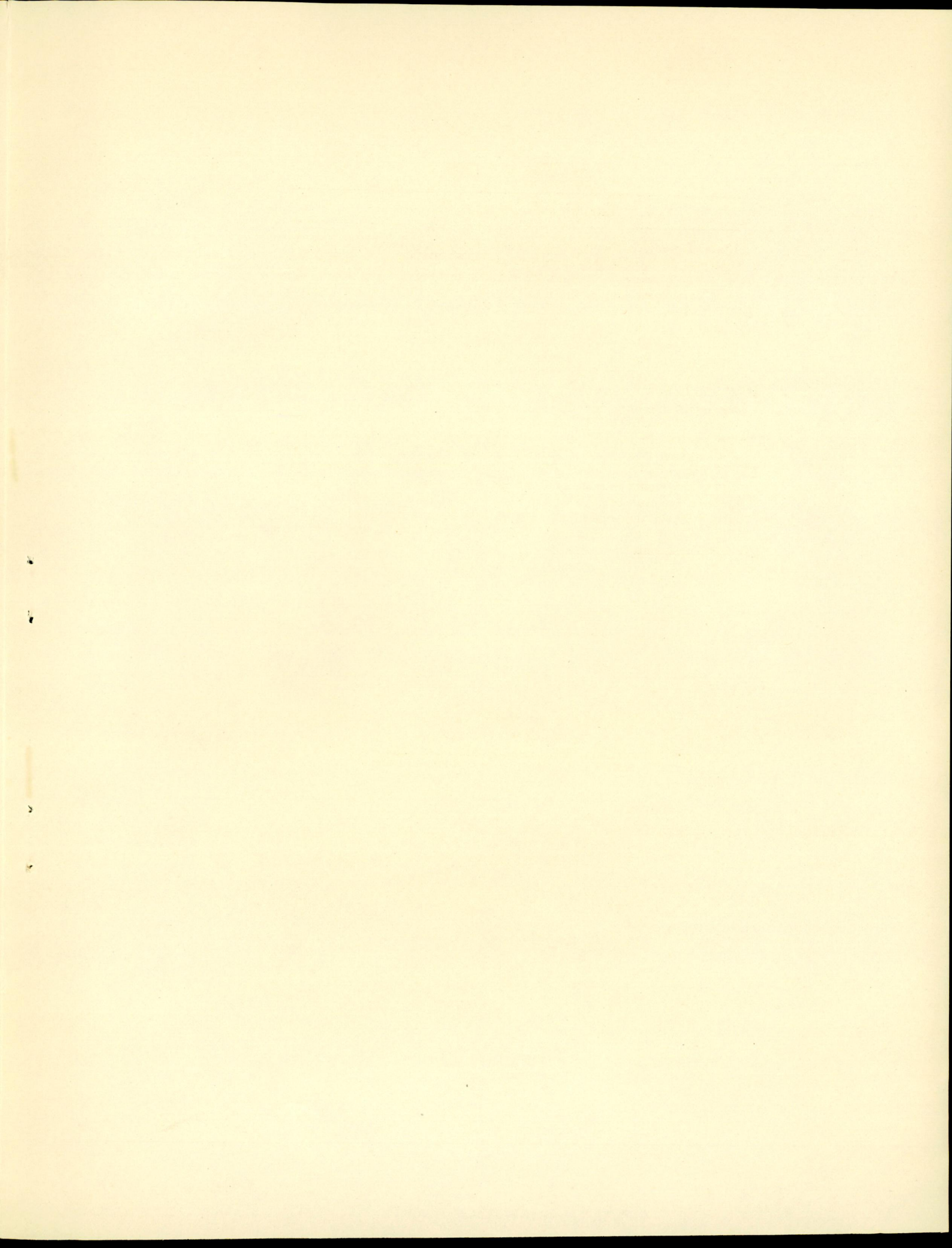

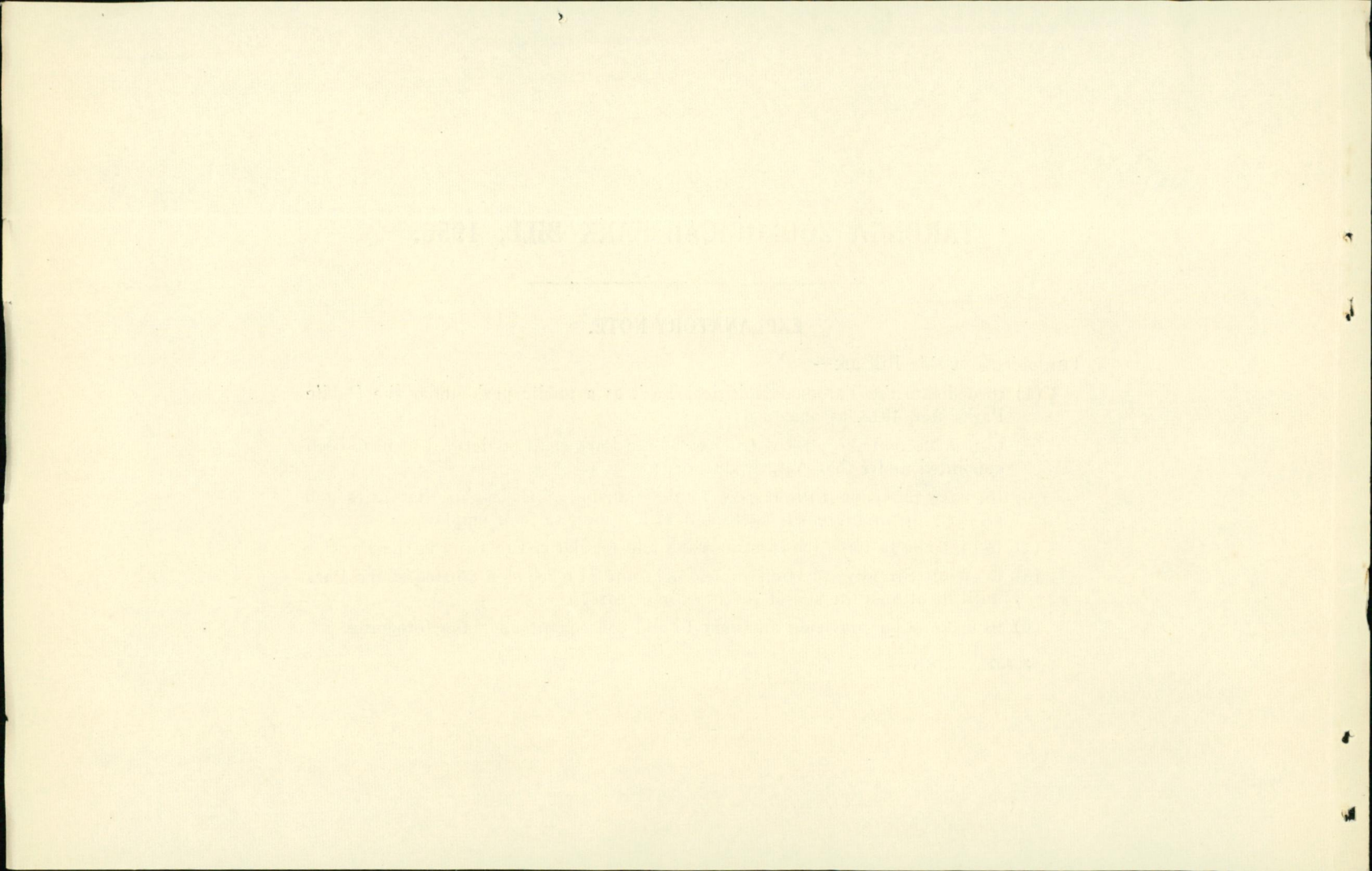

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (1) to dedicate the Taronga Zoological Park as a public park under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended;
- (2) to provide that the present trustees of the Park shall be deemed to have been appointed under that Act, as amended;
- (3) to make provision with respect to the transfer of the rights, liabilities and property of the present trustees and with respect to their employees;
- (4) to continue in force the existing rules and regulations relating to the Park;
- (5) to enable Sir Edward Hallstrom to continue in office as a trustee of the Park until he attains the age of seventy-three years;
- (6) to make other provision ancillary to and consequent upon the foregoing.

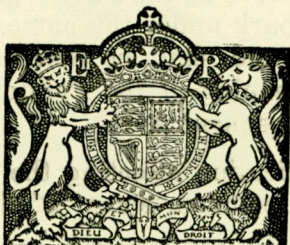

An Act to dedicate Taronga Zoological Park as a public park; to provide that the existing trustees of that Park shall be deemed to have been appointed under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts; to extend the term of office of Sir Edward Hallstrom as a trustee of that Park; to amend the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, the Public Parks Act, 1912, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. **B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Taronga Zoological Park Act, 1956."

Dedication of Taronga Zoological Park as a public park under the Public Parks Act, 1912.

**2.** (1) The land described in the Schedule to this Act (in this Act referred to as the Park land) is hereby dedicated as a public park under the name of the "Taronga Zoological Park" and shall be deemed to be a public park within the meaning of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(2) Any dedication affecting the Park land immediately before the commencement of this Act is hereby revoked.

Trustees of Taronga Zoological Park deemed to be trustees under Public Parks Act, 1912.

**3.** (1) The persons who immediately before the commencement of this Act held office as trustees of the Park land and were appointed to that office under the provisions of subsection one of section twenty-six of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts (in this Act referred to as the former trustees) shall, as on and from that commencement, cease to hold office as such trustees under that Act as so amended, and be deemed to be trustees of the Park land appointed by the Governor under subsection one of section four of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts.

(2) The corporate name of the body corporate comprised of such lastmentioned trustees and their successors (in this Act referred to as the body corporate) shall be deemed to have been prescribed under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, as the "Trustees of Taronga Zoological Park".

(3) The person who immediately before the commencement of this Act held office as trustee of the Park land and was appointed to that office under the provisions

provisions of paragraph (b) of subsection (1A) of section twenty-six of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall, as on and from that commencement, cease to hold office as such trustee under that Act, as so amended, and be deemed to be a trustee of the Park land appointed by the Governor under section 7A of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, by virtue of such person's holding the office or position of Under Secretary for Lands.

4. On and from the commencement of this Act the following provisions shall have effect:—

- (a) All property and all right and interest therein (in this section referred to as the trust property) and all management and control of any thing which immediately before that commencement was vested in or belonged to the former trustees and was held or used by them for or in connection with the Park land shall vest in and belong to the body corporate.
  - (b) All moneys, liquidated and unliquidated claims which, immediately before that commencement, were payable to or recoverable by the former trustees in relation to the Park land or the trust property or any part thereof shall be moneys, liquidated and unliquidated claims payable to or recoverable by the body corporate.
  - (c) All suits, actions and proceedings pending immediately before that commencement at the suit of the former trustees in relation to the Park land or the trust property or any part thereof shall respectively be suits, actions and proceedings pending at the suit of the body corporate.
  - (d) All contracts, agreements and undertakings entered into with and all securities lawfully given to or by the former trustees in relation to

the Park land or the trust property or any part thereof and in force immediately before that commencement shall be deemed to be contracts, agreements and undertakings entered into with and securities given to or by the body corporate.

- (e) The body corporate may pursue the same remedies for the recovery of any such moneys and claims and for the prosecution of such suits, actions and proceedings as the former trustees might have done but for this Act.
- (f) The body corporate may enforce and realise any security or charge existing immediately before that commencement in favour of the former trustees in respect of any such moneys and claims as if such security or charge were existing in favour of the body corporate.
- (g) All debts due and moneys payable by, and all claims, liquidated or unliquidated, recoverable against the former trustees solely relating to the Park land or the trust property or any part thereof shall be debts due and moneys payable by and claims recoverable against the body corporate.
- (h) (i) Every person who immediately before that commencement was a servant of the former trustees in their capacity as trustees of the Park land shall upon that commencement become a servant of the body corporate.  
(ii) The period of service with the former trustees of any person who by virtue of this paragraph becomes a servant of the body corporate shall be deemed to be service with the body corporate for the purposes of annual leave, sick leave or long service leave.

- (iii) Where any condition of employment of any such person was before that commencement regulated by an award or industrial agreement, as defined in the Industrial Arbitration Act, 1940, as amended by subsequent Acts, the condition shall continue to be so regulated until an award, as so defined, regulating the condition and binding the body corporate is made by a competent tribunal or the condition is regulated by an industrial agreement, as so defined, to which the body corporate is a party.

**5.** The rules and regulations made by the former trustees under the authority of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, with respect to the Park land, and in force immediately before the commencement of this Act shall be deemed to be by-laws made with respect to the Park land under the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, and shall be and continue to be in force until amended, replaced or repealed in pursuance of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as so amended.

**6.** Subsection two of section 7E of the Public Parks Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, shall in its application to Sir Edward Hallstrom in his capacity as a trustee of the Taronga Zoological Park be deemed to be amended by omitting therefrom the words "seventy years" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "seventy-three years".

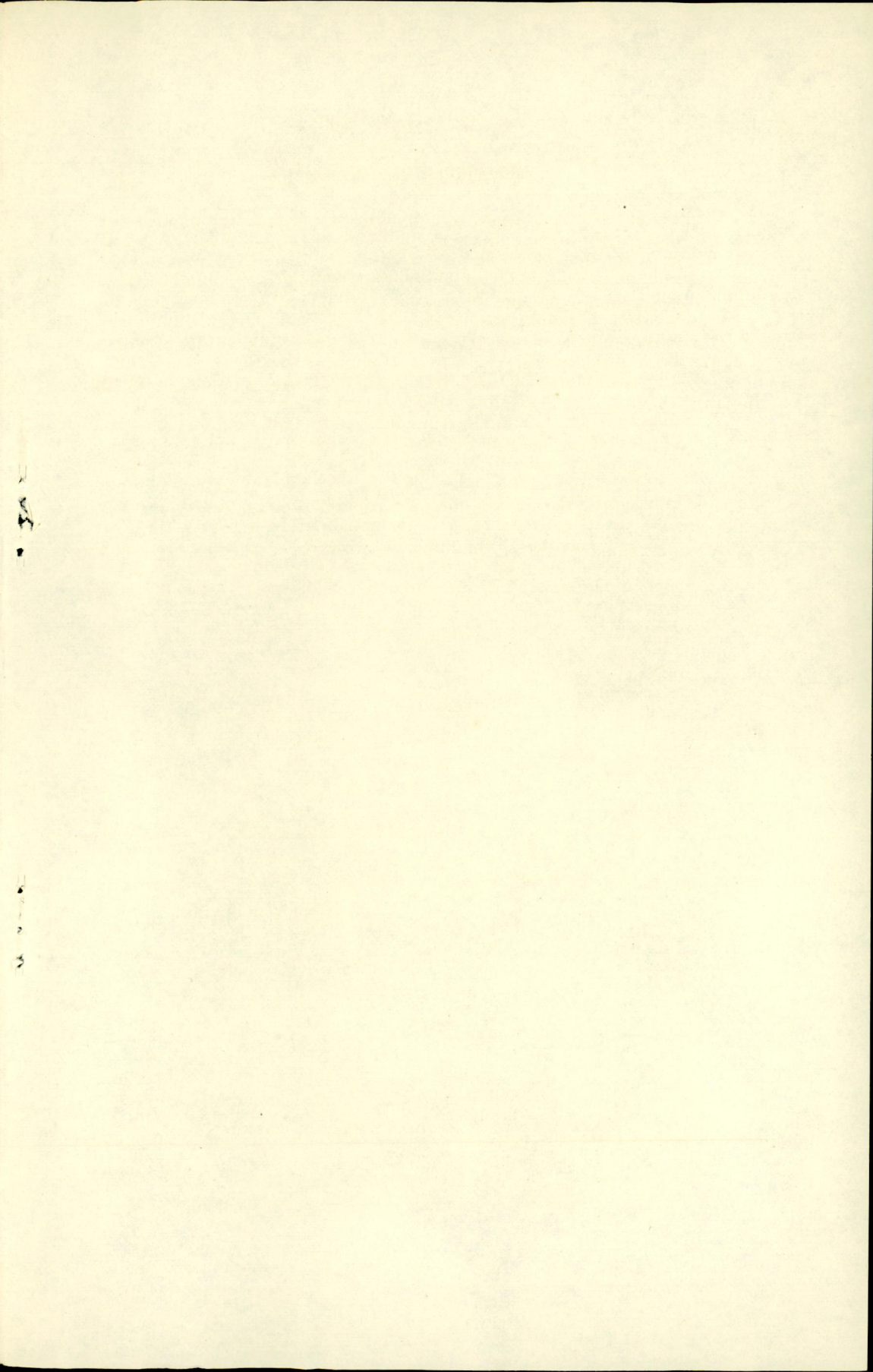

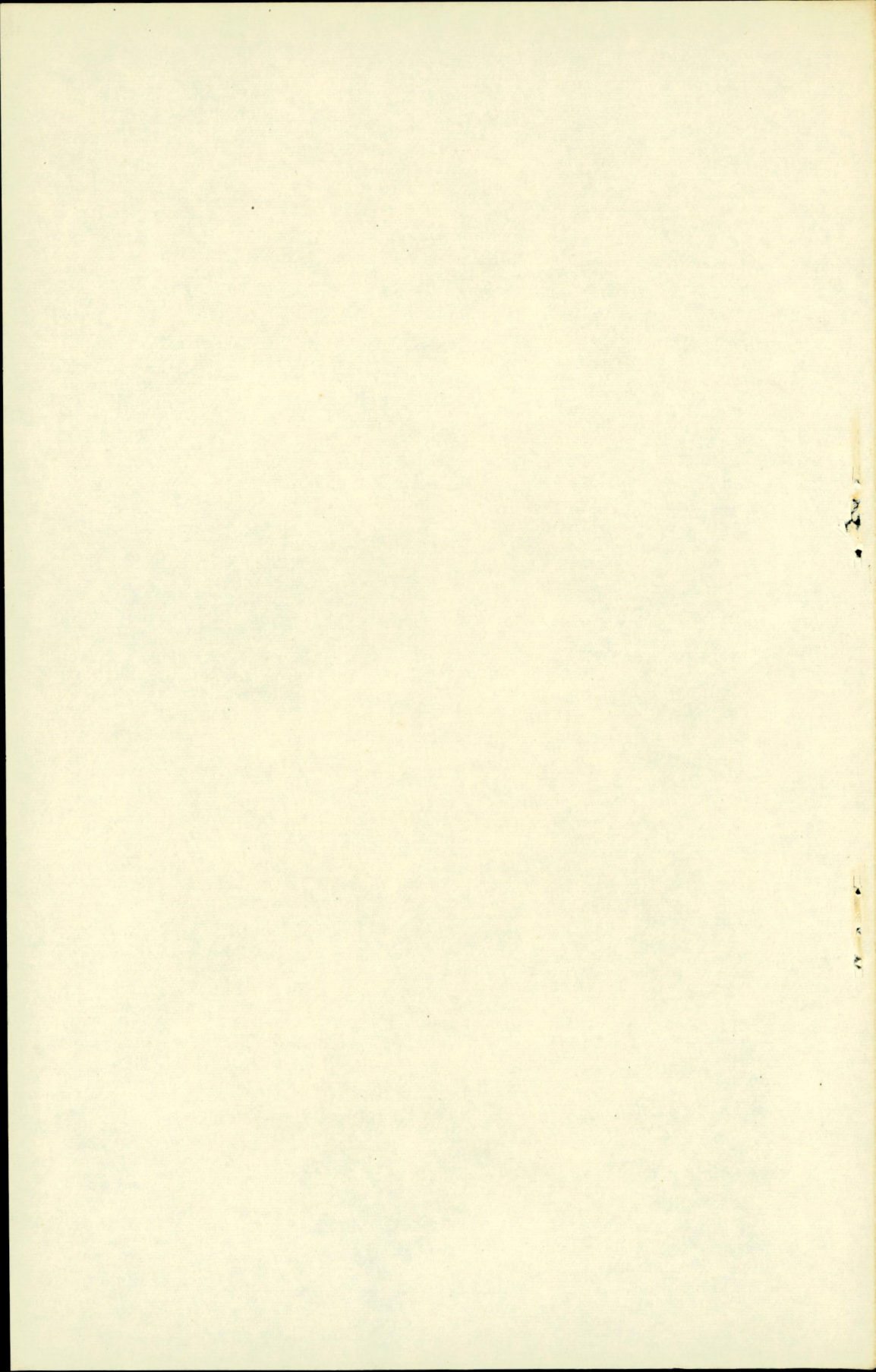

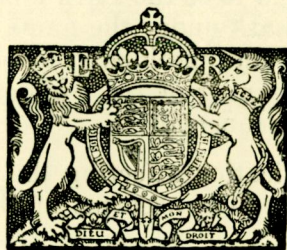
