VETERINARY SURGEONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1957.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are:—

- (1) to extend until 1st April, 1967, the period within which graduates of veterinary schools the degrees of which are not recognised for the purposes of registration under the Veterinary Surgeons Act, 1923, may pass the prescribed examination conducted by the Department of Agriculture or examinations of the University of Sydney in the subjects for the last two years of the course for the degree of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and thereby obtain registration under that Act;
- (2) to extend until 1st April, 1967, the provisions of paragraph (c) of section 24 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act whereunder graduates of veterinary schools the degrees of which are not recognised for the purposes of registration under that Act may practise veterinary science in the course of their employment with and under the supervision of a veterinary surgeon.
