An Act to sanction and to provide for the carrying out of works for the Bermagui Harbour; to validate certain matters; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same. as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Bermagui Harbour Works Act, 1959".

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.

2. (1) (a) The carrying out of the work described in <sup>Work</sup> the Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned. <sub>sanctioned.</sub>

(b) The said work shall be deemed to be an authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts.

10 (c) The Minister for Public Works is empowered to carry out the said work and shall be the constructing authority for the same within the meaning of the said Act, as so amended, and shall enter into such contracts and take all such necessary steps for the proper execution thereof as such authority may think proper.
