## DAIRY INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1960.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to amend the Dairy Industry Act, 1915-1955, to require:—

- (a) packages of table margarine to be labelled with the words “table margarine” and the name and address of the manufacturer; and
- (b) packages of cooking margarine and margarine, manufactured pursuant to section 22B of the Act, to be labelled with the words “cooking margarine” and the name and address of the manufacturer.

DAIRY INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1947

SECTION 1

1. Short title and commencement.

(1) This Act may be called the Dairy Industry (Amendment) Act, 1947.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. Amendment of section 1 of the Dairy Industry Act, 1946.

(1) In section 1 of the Dairy Industry Act, 1946, the definition of "dairy" shall be amended so as to include the following, namely:

115. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions of this section, the court may order that a person liable to a penalty under this section shall be liable to pay the costs of the proceedings.

116. The court may, in any case where it is satisfied that a person is liable to a penalty under this section, order that he pay the costs of the proceedings.

117. It is prohibited for any person who is liable to a penalty under this section to be liable to a penalty under this section.
