BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

FARM PRODUCE AGENTS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1959.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to enable regulations to be made providing for exemptions from certain provisions of the Farm Produce Agents Act, 1926, as amended by subsequent Acts, prohibiting sales of farm produce in certain circumstances and to enable certain persons to be exempted from certain provisions of the regulations made under that Act, as so amended, relating to the keeping of books and records and the delivery and retention of dockets.

FARM PRODUCE AGENTS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1952

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Bill is to confer powers to be made provision for extending the provisions of the Farm Produce Agents Act, 1946, to include the sale of certain agricultural produce in certain circumstances and to confer powers to be exercised in connection with the enforcement of the provisions of the Act as so amended relating to the powers of arrest and recovery and the recovery of costs.
