Act No. 50, 1960.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st November, 1960.]

W HEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its eighty-second Preamble, meeting held on the twenty-third and twenty-fourth days of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one, shall be two hundred and thirty million pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of sixty million six hundred and ninety-four thousand pounds to the State of New South

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.
