South Wales, BE it enacted therefore by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Account Appropriation Act, 1959".
