An Act to alter the titles of certain Ministers of the Crown ; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Ministers of the Crown Short title. Act, 1959".

2. (1) Where, in any Act, by-law, regulation, ordinance or any other instrument or document whatsoever, of the same or a different kind or nature, a Minister of the Crown is referred
