Act No. 7, 1961.

An Act to repeal the Motor Spirit and Substitute Liquid Fuels Act, 1941; to amend the Gas and Electricity Act, 1935-1957; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 14th March, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Motor Spirit and Substitute Liquid Fuels (Repeal) Act, 1961".
- 2. The Motor Spirit and Substitute Liquid Fuels Act, 1941, is hereby repealed.
