## NURSES REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1960.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are-

- (a) to permit registration of psychiatric and infants' nurses at the ages of twenty years and nineteen years respectively instead of twenty-one years, as at present;
- (b) to enlarge the Nurses Registration Board so as to include amongst its members a representative of each of the Hospital Employees' Association, the New South Wales Nurses' Association and the Hospitals Association of New South Wales;
- (c) to alter the designation of "mental nurses" to "psychiatric nurses" and of "assistants in nursing" to "nursing aides";
- (d) to permit the Nurses Registration Board to grant certificates of temporary registration to have effect for limited periods;

An Act to make further provision with respect to the registration of nurses and the constitution of the Nurses Registration Board; for this and other purposes to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1953-1955; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 6th April 1960.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Nurses Registration Short title (Amendment) Act, 1960".
