An Act to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906–1958, so as to increase the superannuation allowances payable to retired members of the Police Force; to amend sections 12c, 33 and 35 of the Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

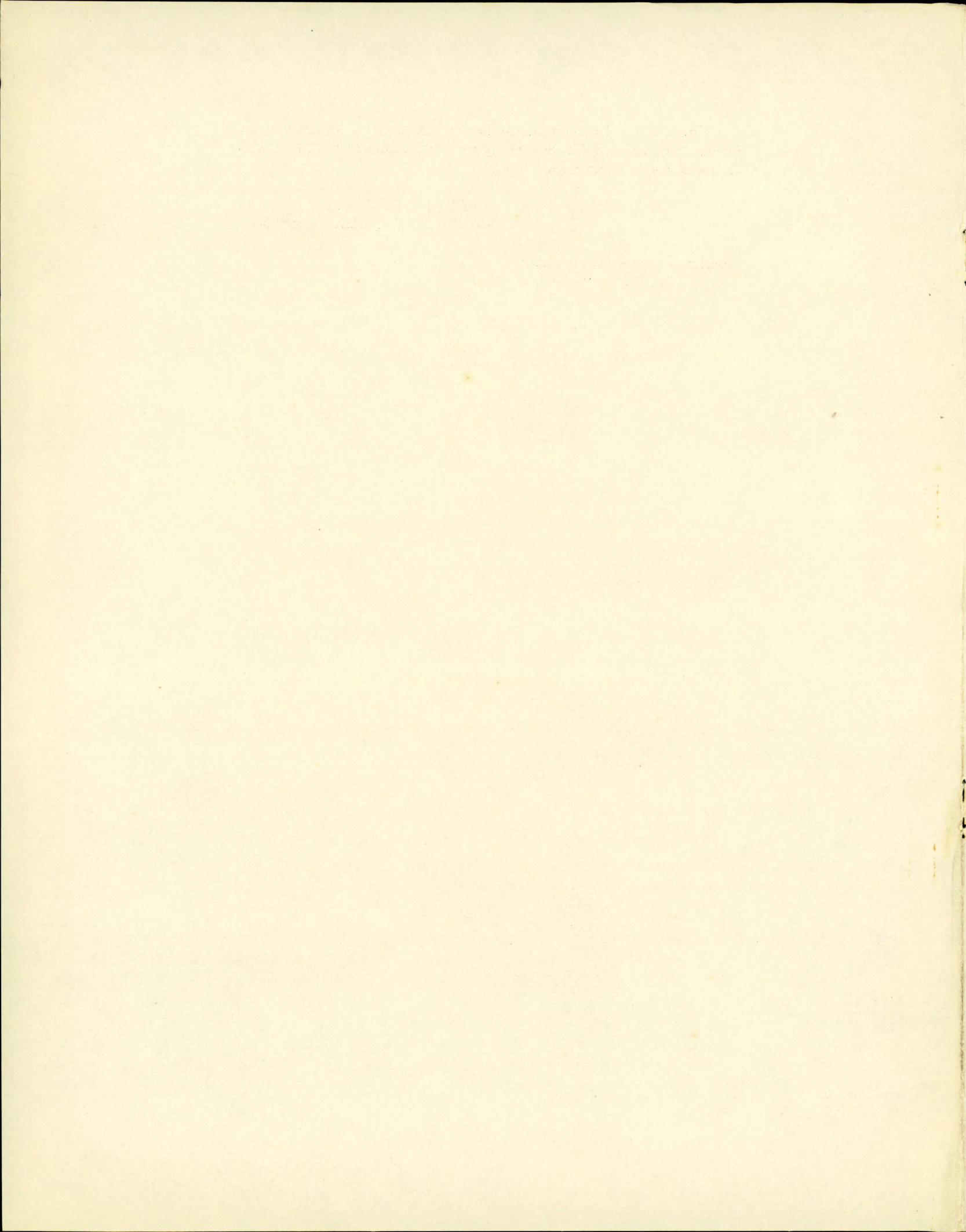

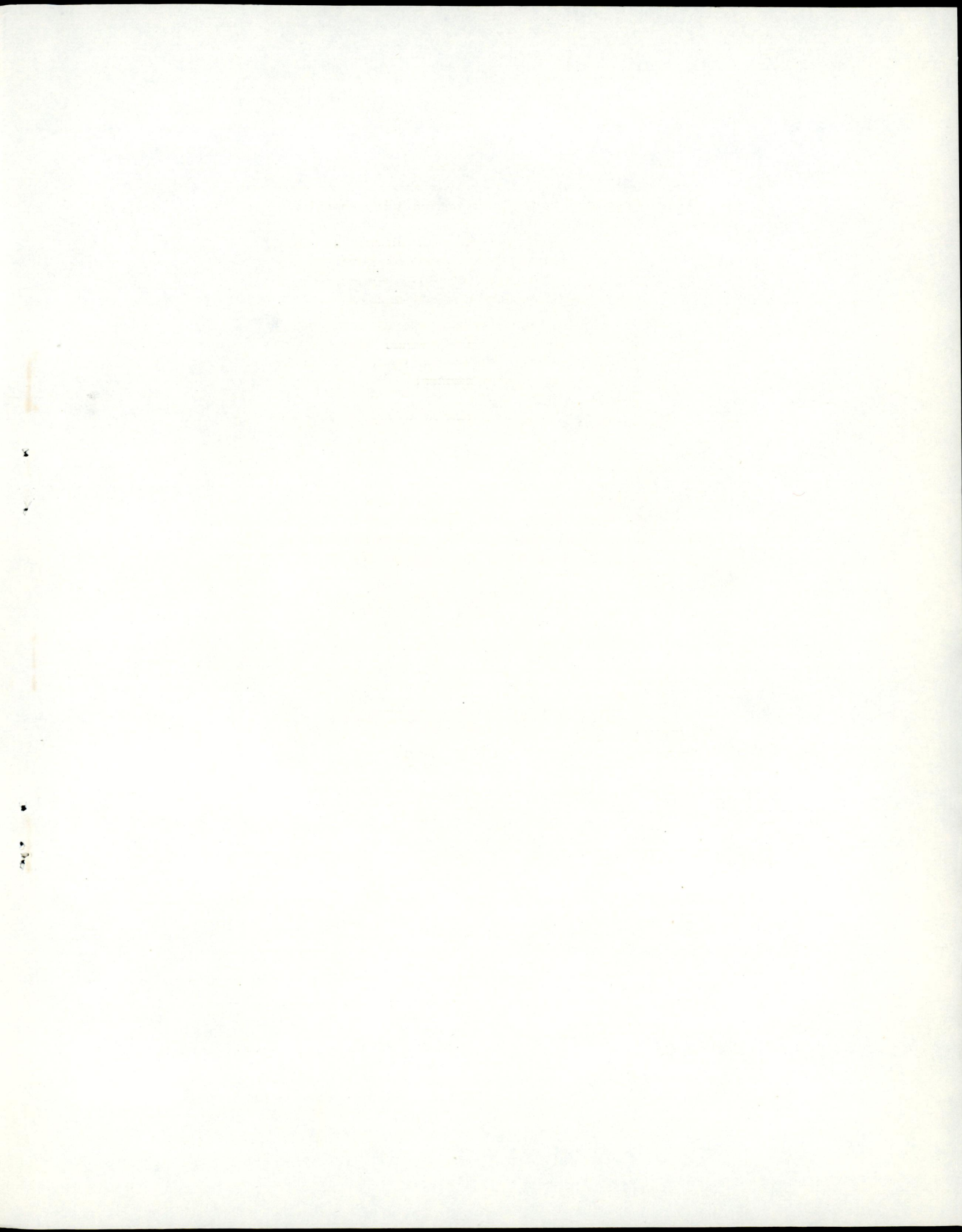

# **POLICE REGULATION AND SUPERANNUATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1960.**

---

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to increase as from 1st May, 1960, police pensions under £456 per annum ;
- (b) to provide that the pension of police retiring medically unfit should begin on the date that extended leave, if taken, would have commenced ;
- (c) to provide that police who retire medically unfit after the commencement of the Police Regulation (Amendment) Act, 1957, and before the commencement of the Police Regulation and Superannuation (Amendment) Act, 1960, should have the period of their long service leave or a certain portion thereof counted as service for superannuation purposes ;
- (d) to provide that police be given the option of working until 60 years of age, 65 years of age in the case of the Commissioner of Police, and being paid the monetary value of extended leave as a gratuity ;
- (e) to provide that in future a person in receipt of any allowance or superannuation under the Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended, shall not be required to obtain the approval of the Governor before leaving the State ;
- (f) to provide that in lieu of requiring notice of a proposed sale of unclaimed goods to be inserted thrice in the Government Gazette that such notice be published in a newspaper circulating in the district in which the sale is to take place ;
- (g) to make other provisions ancillary to the foregoing.
