An Act to amend the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Act, 1906–1958, so as to increase the superannuation allowances payable to retired members of the Police Force; to amend sections 12c, 33 and 35 of the Police Regulation Act, 1899, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 1st December, 1960.]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—






