RADIOACTIVE SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1961.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to require medical practitioners, dentists and veterinary surgeons who have possession of or use irradiating apparatus for diagnostic radiography purposes in the course of their professions and who are at present not required to hold licenses under the Radioactive Substances Act, 1957, to become holders of licenses under that Act.

RADIOACTIVE SUBSTANCES (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1961

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Bill is to amend the Radioactive Substances Act, 1948, so as to provide for the control of radioactive substances and for the protection of the public and the environment against the hazards of such substances. The Bill also provides for the control of the export of radioactive substances from India to other countries.
