Statutory Salaries Adjustment.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : —

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statutory Salaries Adjustment Act, 1960". Short title.

2. (1) The salary payable to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Act pursuant to the enactment specified opposite that office in the second column of that Schedule is hereby increased to the amount specified opposite that office in the third column of that Schedule. Salaries of officers specified in First Schedule.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven.

3. (1) The salary payable to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Act pursuant to the enactment specified opposite that office in the second column of that Schedule is hereby increased to the amount specified opposite that office in the third column of that Schedule. Salaries of officers specified in Second Schedule.

(2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced upon the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-seven.

4.
