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# Act No. , 1960.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1960–1961.

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### WHEREAS

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Preamble. subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Forty millions five hundred and forty-four thousand seven hundred pounds, that is to say—

- Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Twenty-three millions seven hundred and ninety-three thousand seven hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
- Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Twelve millions seven hundred and forty-three thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
- Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the sum of Two hundred and sixty-six thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
- Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of Six hundred and forty-eight thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions one hundred and ninety thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.

- Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and fiftynine thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
- Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, the sum of Four hundred and ninety-one thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
- Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, the sum of One hundred and fifty-two thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to Your Majesty : Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice

advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : ---

Estimates for the financial year ending thirtieth day of June. one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one, as laid upon the Table of the House, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-one, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1960-1961.

Out of the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund there £152.000 shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making may be issued out good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, of the the sum of One hundred and fifty-two thousand pounds to be Sydney Harbour expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for Trust the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand Renewals nine hundred and sixty-one, as laid upon the Table of the House, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New

New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixtyone, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1960-1961.

9. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for Treasurer the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions to pay under Governor's as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his Warrant hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to or Order. time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Renewals Fund, respectively.

10. The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time Treasurer be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in to have credit and pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of receipts to the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall discharge him. be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

11. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1960."
