# SYDNEY HARBOUR BRIDGE (FURTHER WORKS) AND MAIN ROADS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1960.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

  - (iii) the cost of acquiring property for the Warringah Expressway Approach;
- (e) to authorise the Commissioner for Main Roads to carry out certain works in connection with inner city expressways, the cost of such works being charged to the County of Cumberland Main Roads Fund;
- (f) to validate certain matters;
- (g) to make other amendments of a consequential or ancillary character.
