EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are:—

- (a) to dedicate certain land for public recreation and to appoint the trustees of the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground as trustees of such land;

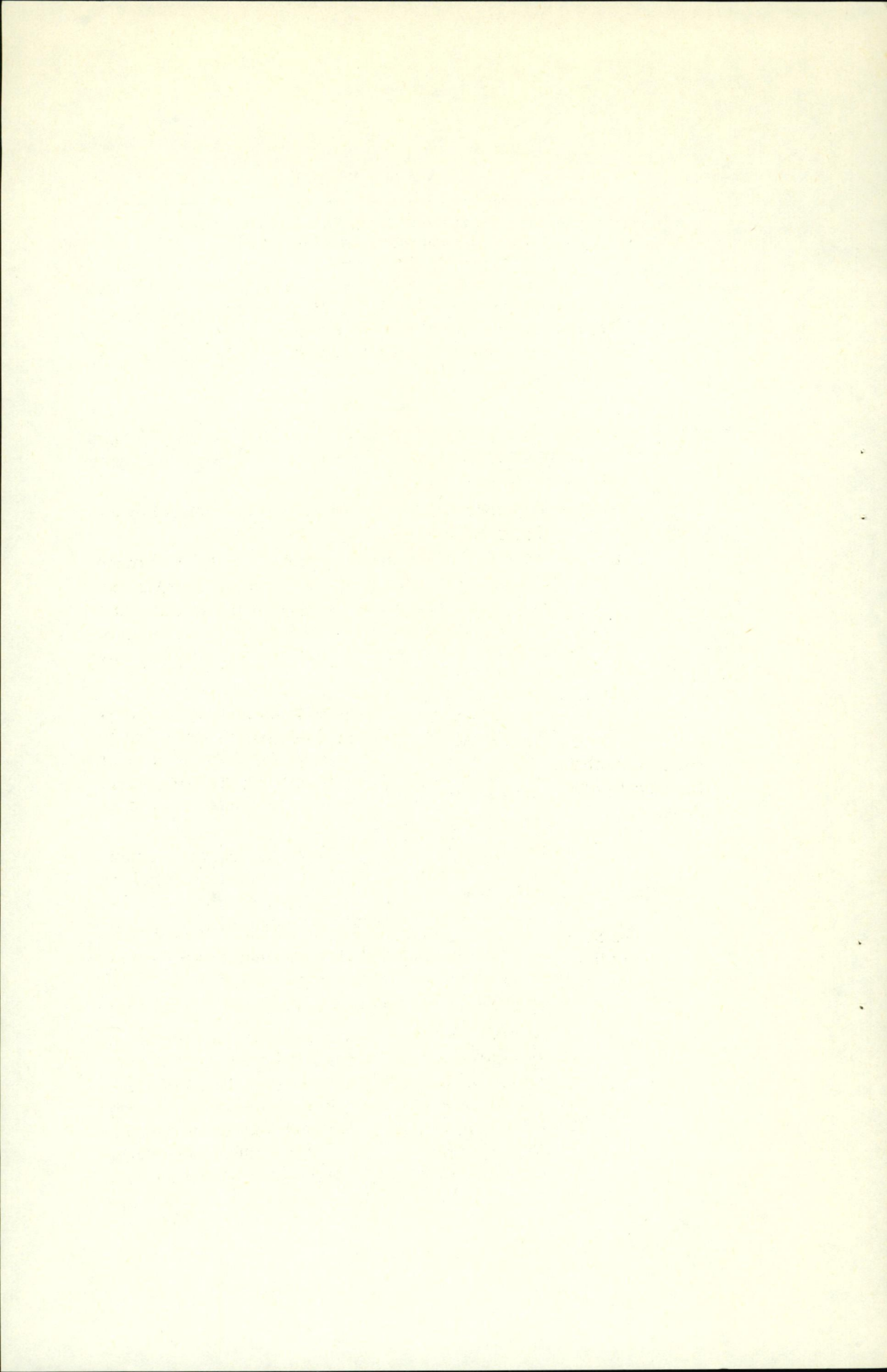

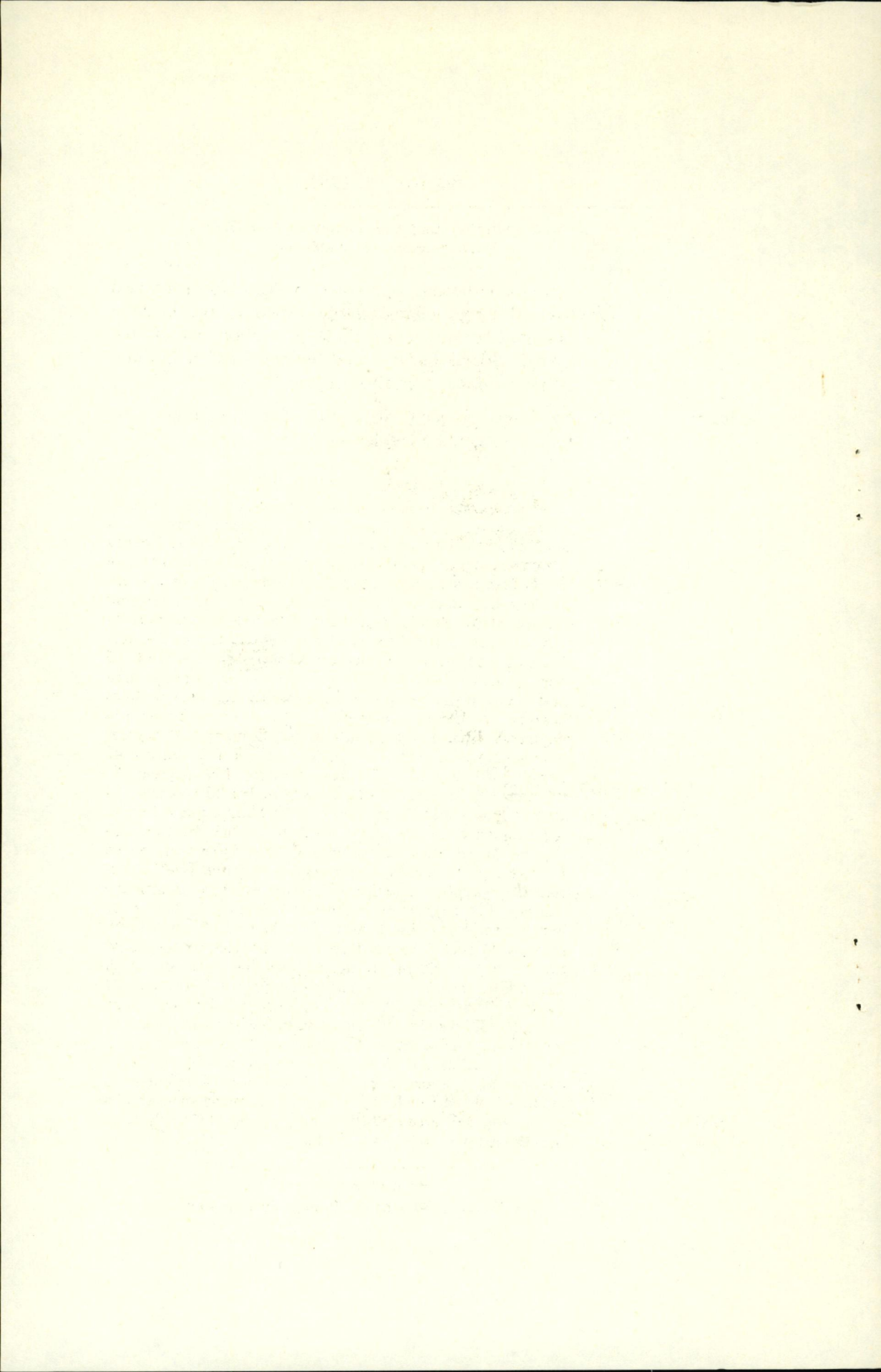
