Act No. 15, 1959.

An Act to provide for the addition of certain land to the areas known as the Sydney Sports Ground and the Sydney Cricket Ground No. 2; for this and other purposes to amend the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, the Sydney Sports Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation Act, 1951, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 1st October, 1959.]

B E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows : —

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Sports Short title Ground and Sydney Cricket Ground Amalgamation and citation. (Amendment) Act, 1959".
