**WAR SERVICE LAND SETTLEMENT (AMENDMENT) BILL,

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to reduce from ten years to five years the period during which a war service land settlement holding may not be transferred to a person who does not hold a qualification certificate.
