

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

At present, an appeal under the Crown Employees Appeal Board Act, 1944–1964, does not lie in respect of a promotion or appointment to a permanent position, the salary for which exceeds two thousand nine hundred pounds.

The object of this Bill is to enable appeals under that Act to be brought in respect of promotions or appointments to permanent positions, the salary for which does not exceed three thousand five hundred pounds.


