



DRIED FRUITS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1964.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to increase the maximum sum which a person in whose name a packing house is registered may be required to contribute annually to the New South Wales Dried Fruits Board from 1/32nd to 1/16th of a penny per pound of the quantity of dried fruits sold, or forwarded for the purposes of trade or sale, from such packing house during the next preceding year.


