### EXPLANATORY NOTE.

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

- (b) all mines or deposits of coal, ironstone, kerosene 30 shale, limestone, slate or other minerals in and under the said lands, which, immediately before such commencement, were vested in any person other than the Crown.

Without limiting the generality of such covenants, conditions and reservations, the consideration or rent payable in 10 respect of any such sale or lease shall, having regard to the purposes and circumstances relating to such sale or lease, be such as may reasonably be obtainable.
