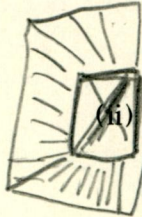

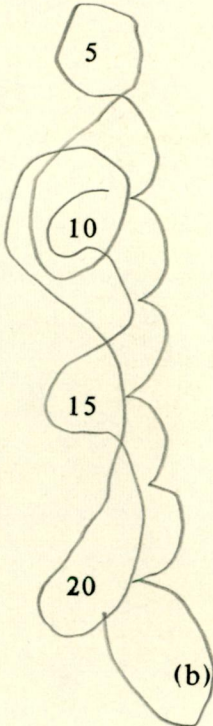
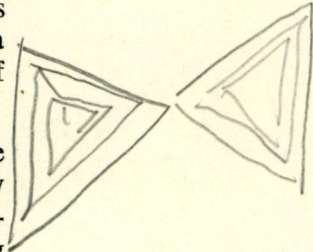

MILK (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1964.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to redefine and delimit the extent of the exemption from the vesting provisions of the Milk Act, 1931, as amended, conferred on dairymen-vendors by section 26 of that Act, as amended;
- (b) to remove the similar exemption conferred on dairymen-vendors by section 26A of that Act, as amended;
- (c) to make other provisions ancillary to the foregoing.

MILK (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1964

THE MILK (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1964

The object of the Bill is to amend the Milk Act, 1948, in relation to the powers of the Milk Producers' Committees and the Milk Producers' Associations in relation to the supply of milk to the public.

1. In section 2 of the Milk Act, 1948, the definition of "milk" shall be amended to include milk which is produced in the State and is intended for sale to the public.

2. In section 3 of the Milk Act, 1948, the powers of the Milk Producers' Committees shall be amended to include the power to make regulations for the supply of milk to the public.

3. In section 4 of the Milk Act, 1948, the powers of the Milk Producers' Associations shall be amended to include the power to make regulations for the supply of milk to the public.
