- (c) by omitting paragraph (c) of subsection one of section six and by inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph : —
 - (c) becomes a mentally ill person, a protected person or an incapable person within the meaning of the Mental Health Act, 1958, as amended by subsequent Acts;

(d) (i) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection four of section eleven the word, symbols and letter "and (e)" and by inserting in lieu thereof the symbols, letters and word ", (e) and (ei)";

- (ii) by inserting next after paragraph (b) of the same subsection the following new paragraph: —
 - (bi) in meeting costs of membership of the Council in or affiliating with any organisations, societies or other bodies, whether in Australia or elsewhere, which have objects similar to those set out in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) of subsection one of section four of this Act;

(e) by omitting from section twelve the word, symbols and letter "and (e)" and by inserting in lieu thereof the symbols, letters and word ", (e) and (ei)".
