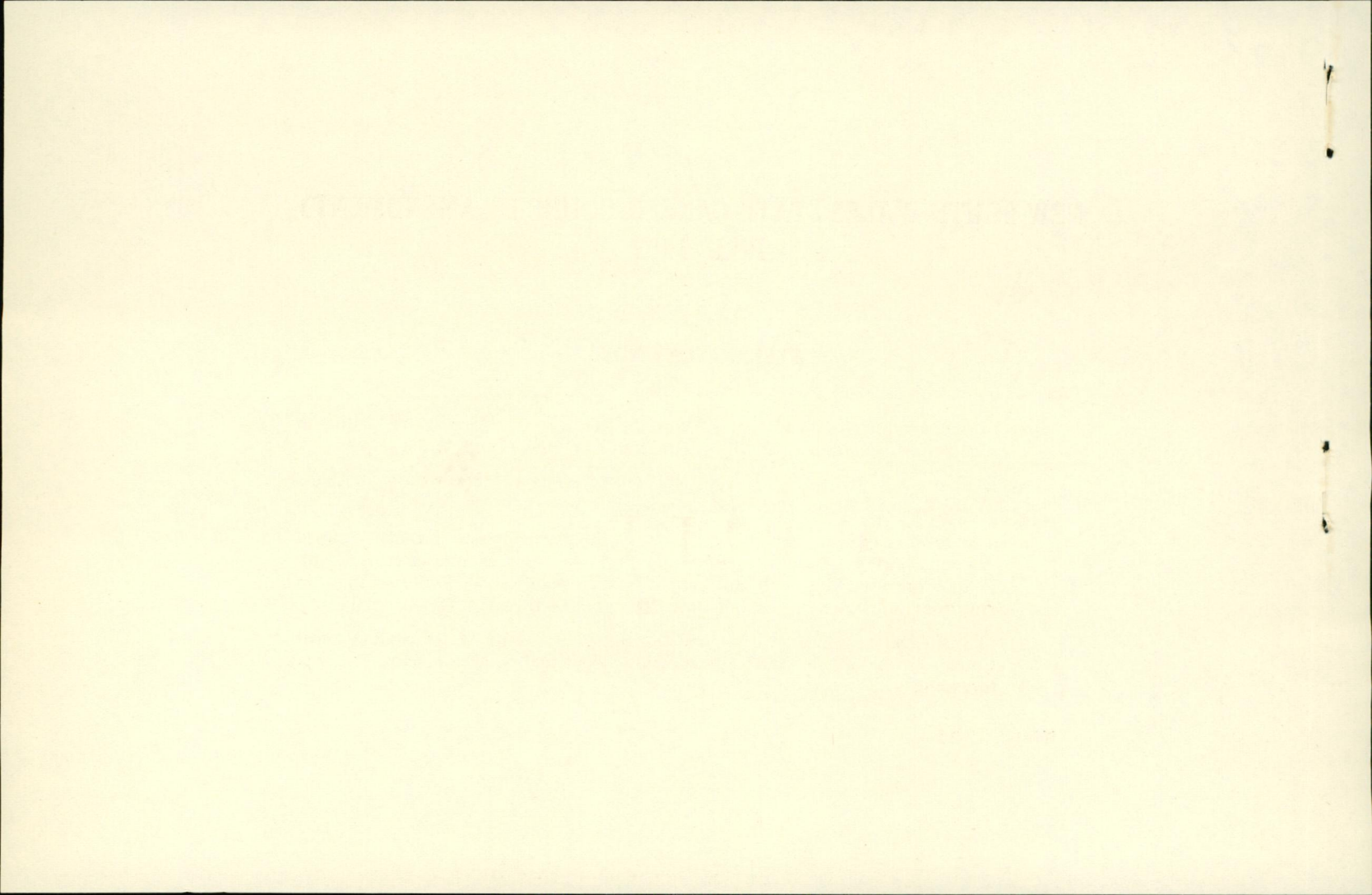

## EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—
