EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are to-

- (a) provide for the registration of Mothercraft Nurses;
- (b) provide for the appointment of a professor of the University of New South Wales as an additional member of the Nurses Registration Board;
- (c) provide that the Registrar of the Nurses Registration Board shall be appointed under the provisions of the Public Service Act;
- (d) simplify the procedure in cases where a nurse is entitled to have the particulars and matters prescribed by the Act entered in more than one subdivision of the Register;


