RACING (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1963.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to provide that for the purposes of the Finance (Taxation) Act, 1915, as amended by subsequent Acts, and Parts III and V of the Bookmakers (Taxation) Act, 1917, as amended by subsequent Acts, the Penrith Showground shall be deemed to be beyond forty miles from the General Post Office, Sydney ;
- (b) to require any club conducting a race-meeting on the Penrith Showground to pay to the Treasurer the same proportion of totalizator commission collected by it as is payable by clubs conducting race-meetings on Menangle Park racecourse, Hawkesbury racecourse and any racecourse situated beyond forty miles from the General Post Office, Sydney ;
- (c) to make other provisions ancillary to the foregoing.
