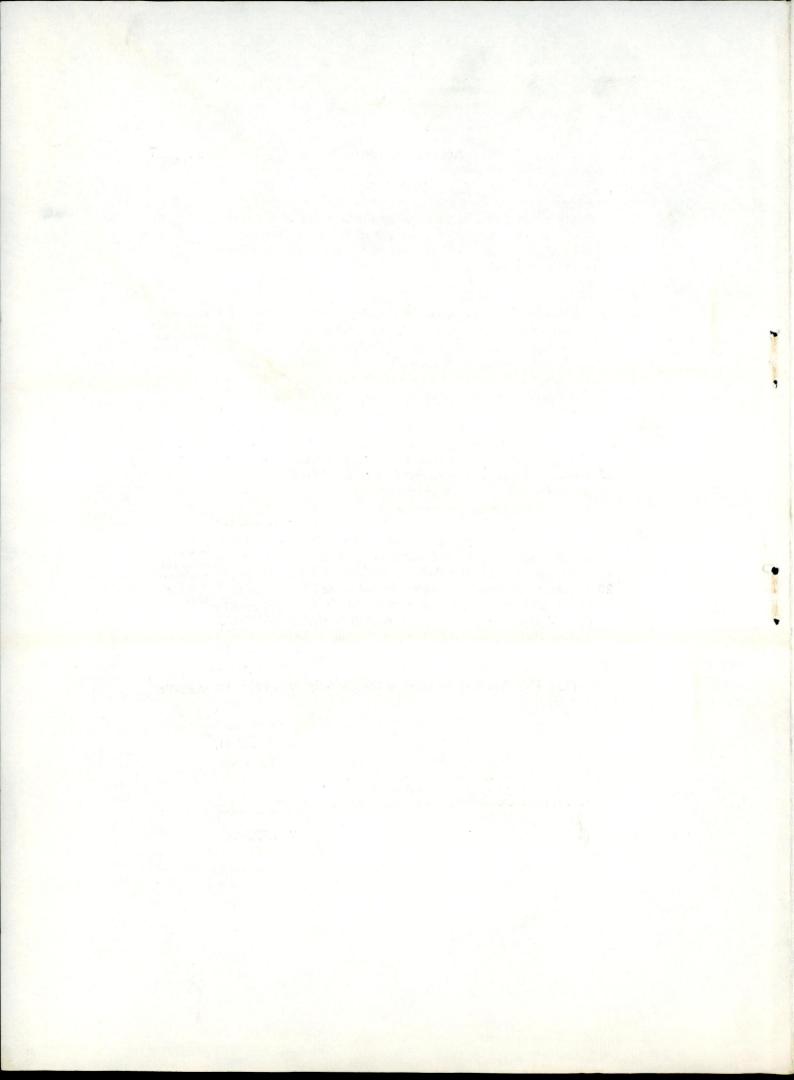

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1963-1964. [Assented to, 13th September, 1963.]

- Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and forty thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

- Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions one hundred thousand pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
- Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and forty-two thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
- Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and fifty-four thousand seven hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.
- Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, the sum of One hundred and eighty-six thousand five hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to Your Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice
