# ELIZABETHÆ II REGINÆ

Act No. 32, 1964.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, towards the services of the Year 1964–1965. [Assented to, 29th September, 1964.]

**WHEREAS** 

Preamble.

W HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Forty-seven millions five hundred and ninety-three thousand one hundred pounds, that is to say—

- Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Twenty-nine millions four hundred and twenty-five thousand three hundred pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.
- Out of the Government Railways Fund, the sum of Thirteen millions four hundred and twenty-five thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.
- Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the sum of Three hundred and thirty-three thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.
- Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the sum of One million and thirty-seven thousand two hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months

of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two millions and thirty-eight thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-two thousand six hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, the sum of Two hundred and twelve thousand three hundred pounds to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following

following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five.

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds the sum so granted to Your Majesty: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

£29,425,300 may be issued out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

1. Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Twenty-nine millions four hundred and twenty-five thousand three hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

£13,425,800 may be issued out of the Government Railways Fund.

2. Out of the Government Railways Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Thirteen millions four hundred and twenty-five thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

3. Out of the Government Railways Renewals Fund there £333,300 shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making may be issued out good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, of the the sum of Three hundred and thirty-three thousand three Government Railways hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been Renewals sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June. Fund. one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Railways during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

Out of the Road Transport and Traffic Fund there £1,037,200 shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making may be issued out good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, of the Road the sum of One million and thirty-seven thousand two hun-Transport and Traffic dred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been Fund. sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June. one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Motor Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

Out of the Metropolitan Transport Trust General £2,038,800 Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or may be towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted of the Metto Her Majesty, the sum of Two millions and thirty-eight ropolitan Transport thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates Trust which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended General Fund. thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixtyfour, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day

of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

£237,800 may be issued out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund.

6. Out of the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and thirty-seven thousand eight hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Department of Government Transport during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

£882,600 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Fund.

7. Out of the Maritime Services Board Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Eight hundred and eighty-two thousand six hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

£212,300 may be issued out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund.

8. Out of the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to Her Majesty, the sum of Two hundred and twelve thousand three hundred pounds to be expended at the rates which have been sanctioned for the financial year ended thirtieth day of June,

one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, to defray the salaries, maintenance and working expenses and other expenses of the Maritime Services Board of New South Wales during the months of October and November or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1964-1965.

- The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for Treasurer the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions to pay under Governor's as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his Warrant hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to or Order. time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund, and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, respectively.
- The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time Treasurer 10. be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in to have pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of receipts to the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall discharge him. be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned. and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.

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- 9. The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for Treasurer the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions to pay under as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his Warrant hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to or Order. time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways Fund, the Government Railways Renewals Fund, the Road Transport and Traffic Fund, the Metropolitan Transport Trust General Fund, the Newcastle and District Transport Trust General Fund, the Maritime Services Board Fund, and the Maritime Services Board Renewals Fund, respectively.

The Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time Treasurer be allowed credit for all sums of money paid by him in to have pursuance of such Warrants or Orders, and the receipts of receipts to the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall discharge be full and valid discharges to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for such sums as shall be therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
  - 11. This Act may be cited as the "Supply Act, 1964." Short title.
