

## EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are-

- (a) to require the rules, and any alteration or repeal of the rules, and any new rule, of the Country Women's Association of New South Wales to be registered in the Companies Office instead of the office for the registration of deeds at Sydney;
- (b) to require the Registrar-General to transfer certain documents relating to the Association to the Registrar of Companies;
- (c) to validate past registrations of the rules of the Association; and
- (d) to make other provisions of a minor character.
