EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to reconstitute the Sydney County Council so that it shall consist of eight members, two of whom instead of three shall be elected to that council as representatives of the First Constituency ;
- (b) to transfer the local government area of Marrickville from the Second to the First Constituency of the Sydney County Council ;
- (c) to make other provisions of a minor or ancillary character.
