An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith.

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its ninetieth meeting ^{Preamble.} held on the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, shall be two hundred and ninety-five million pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of seventy-six million and seventy-five thousand pounds to the State of New South Wales for public works, BE it enacted therefore by the

General Loan Account Appropriation.

the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "General Loan Account Short title, Appropriation Act, 1965".

2. The sum of ninety-one million one hundred and seventy-two thousand pounds is hereby appropriated from the General Loan Account for the public works and services hereunder set out, and shall, as required, be applied as follows:—

Act No. 17, 1965.

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 1st December, 1965.]

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its ninetieth meeting Preamble. held on the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-six, shall be two hundred and ninety-five million pounds, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of seventy-six million and seventy-five thousand pounds to the State of New South Wales for public works, BE it enacted therefore by the
