An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum out of the General Loan Account and for the application of that sum for certain Public Works and Services; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th November, 1967.]

WHEREAS the Australian Loan Council at its ninety-third Preamble. meeting held on the twenty-eighth and twenty-ninth days of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, decided in pursuance of Clause 3 (9) of Part I of the Agreement set out in the schedule to the Financial Agreement Act, 1944, that the amount to be borrowed for the loan programmes of the Commonwealth and the States for housing and State works for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, shall be six hundred and seventy-seven million dollars, and by unanimous decision allocated an amount of one hundred and seventy-two million two hundred and forty thousand dollars
