An Act to make further provision with respect to the sale and supply of liquor; for this purpose to amend the Liquor Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Liquor (Amendment) Act, 1967".
