(2) The Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts, by 10 proclamations pursuant to section 36A of that Act and by this Act, may be cited as the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924–1966.

(3) The Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts and by 15 proclamations pursuant to section 36A of that Act, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

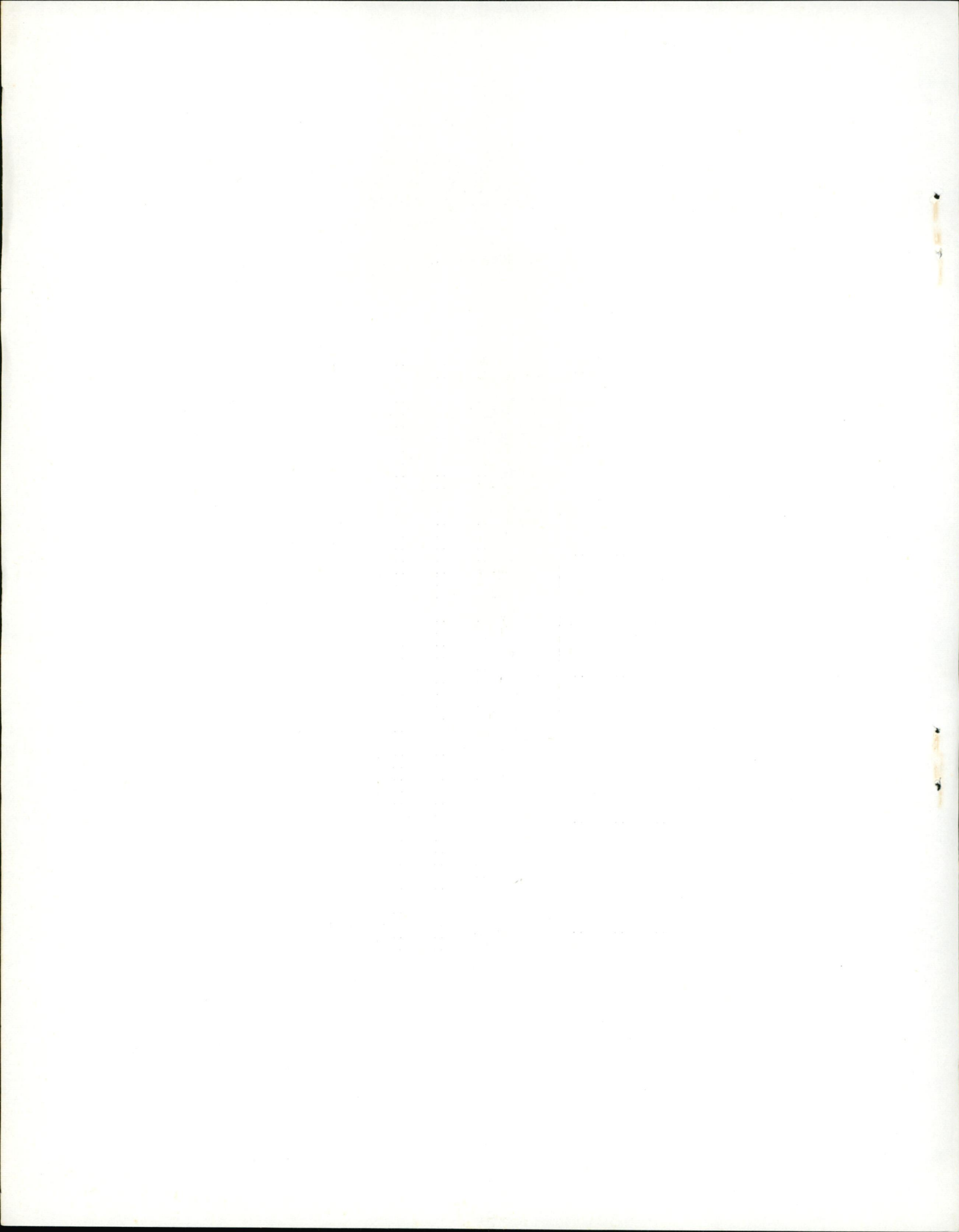
