An Act to sanction and to provide for the construction of a rock-fill dam across the Severn River about fifteen miles upstream of its junction with Frazer's Creek and works incidental thereto; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

PINDARI DAM BILL, 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE Bill sanctions and provides for the construction of—

- (a) a rock-fill dam across the Severn River about 15 miles upstream of its junction with Frazer's Creek—which junction is near the town of Ashford—of a height sufficient to store about 30,000 acre feet of water for irrigation purposes;
- (b) necessary spillways and gates and outlet works for regulation of the discharge of water from the storage.

The Bill provides that the work shall be deemed an authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, and that The Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission shall be the Constructing Authority for the work.

The estimated cost of the work is \$7,000,000.
