An Act to make further provision with respect to the radiological examination of persons for tuberculosis; to increase the penalties for offences under the Public Health Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts; for these and other purposes to amend that Act, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

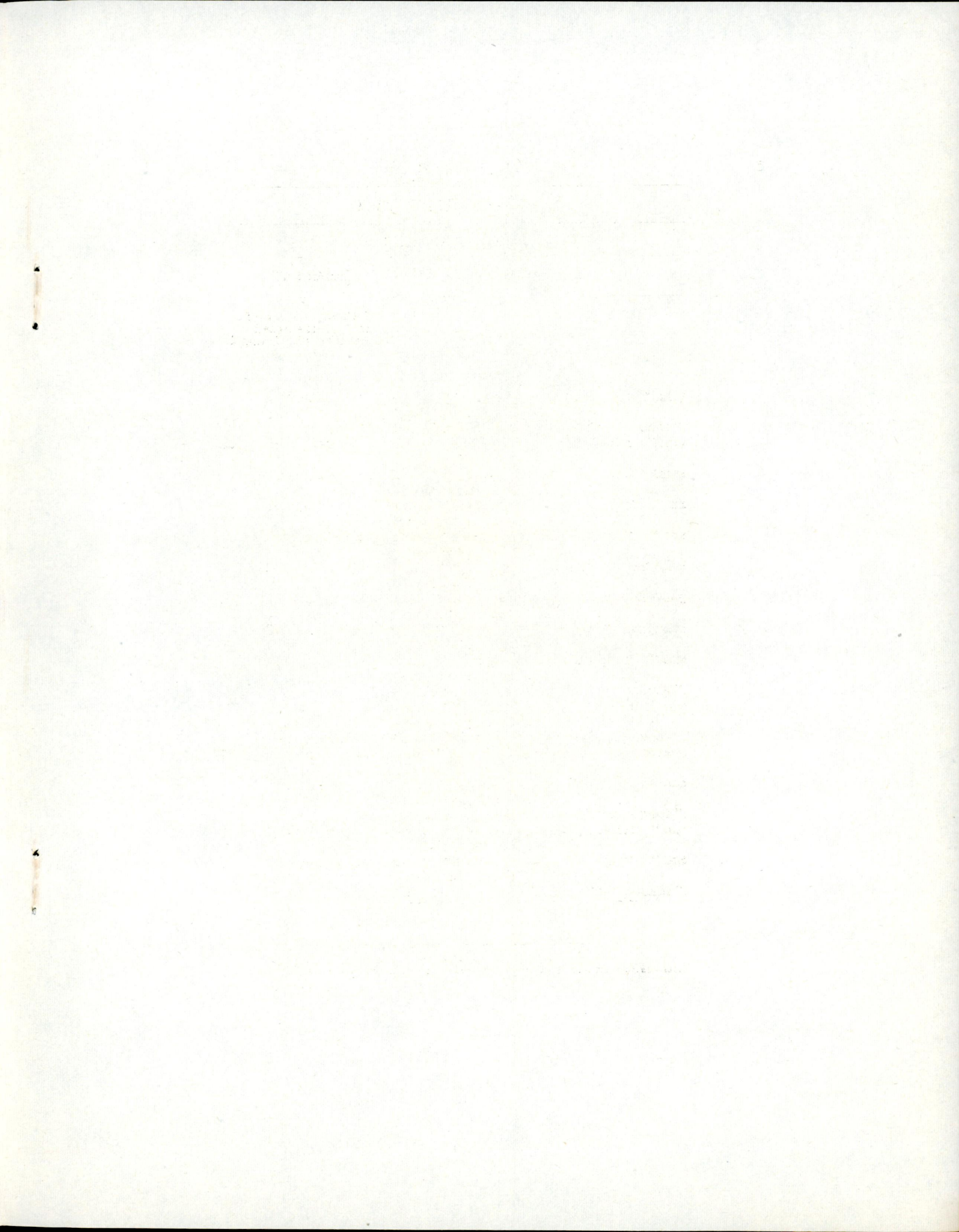

PUBLIC HEALTH (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1965.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to amend the Public Health Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts—
 - (i) to provide that the appointed members of the Board of Health shall hold office for a period not exceeding five years;
 - (ii) to make more flexible the power of the Governor to direct categories of persons to submit to radiological examination for tuberculosis;
 - (iii) to enable certain officers to be authorised to lay or make informations or complaints under that Act, as so amended, either generally or in any particular case or class of cases; and
 - (iv) to increase the penalties imposed under that Act; and
- (b) to make other provisions of a minor or consequential character.

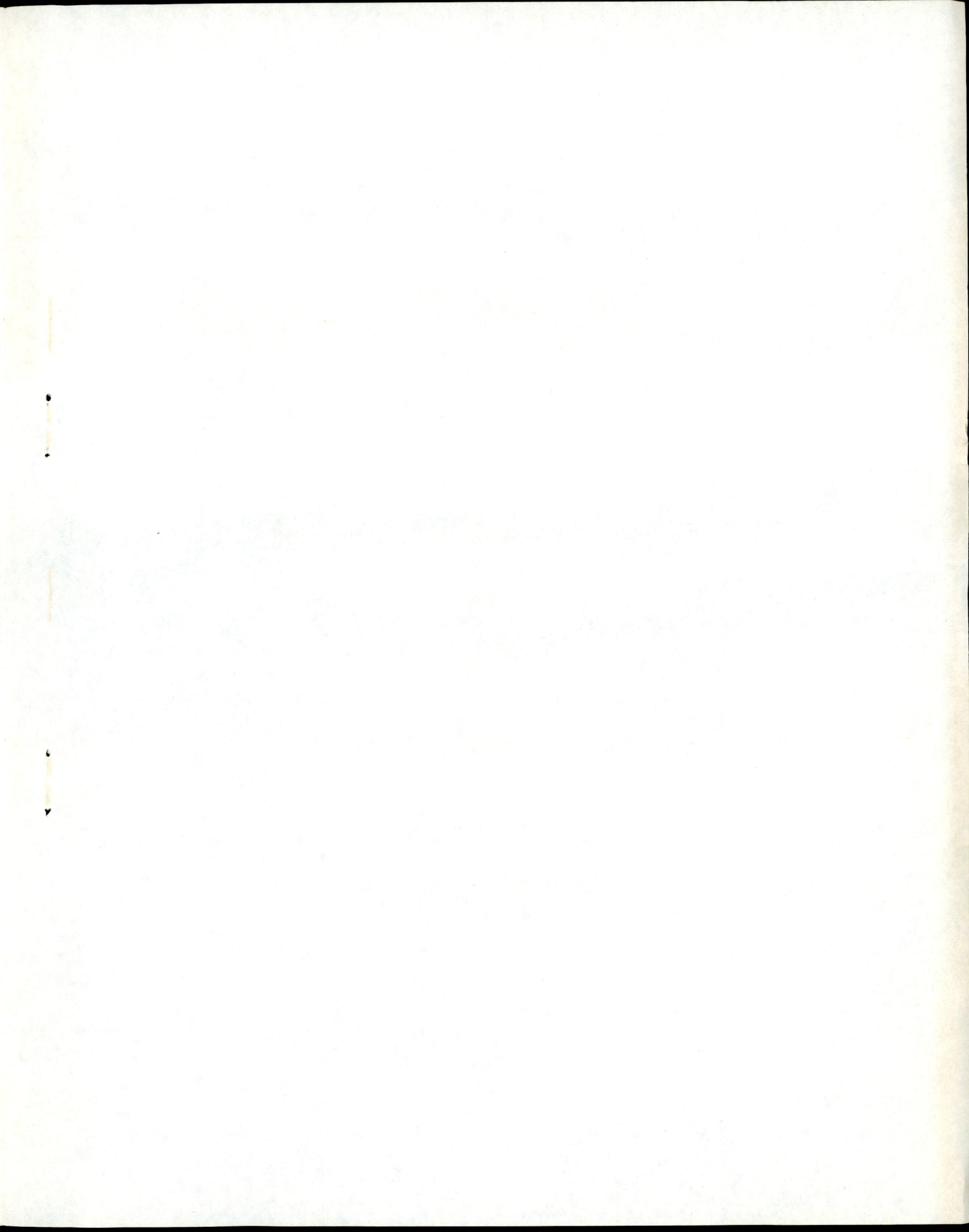

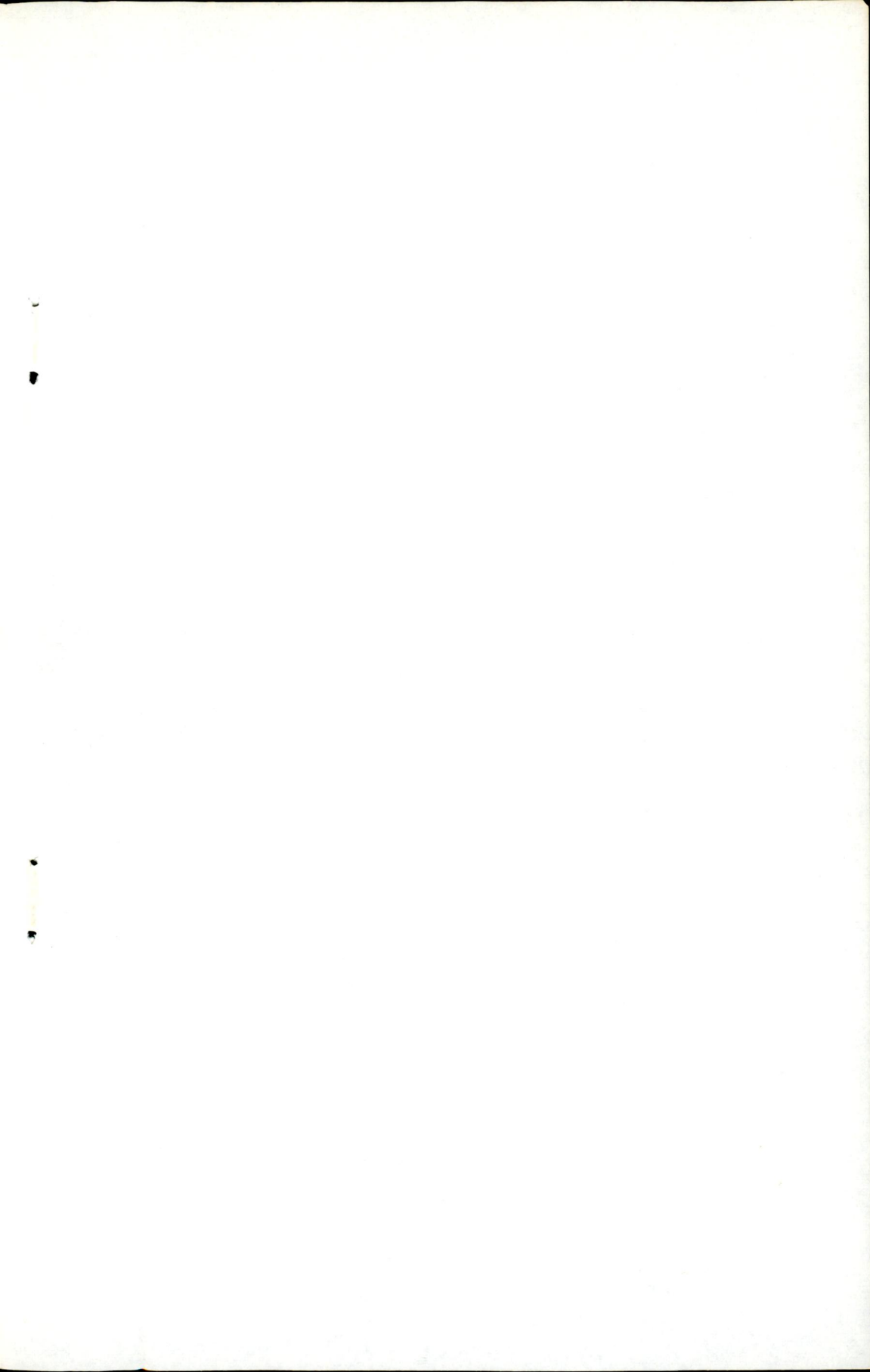

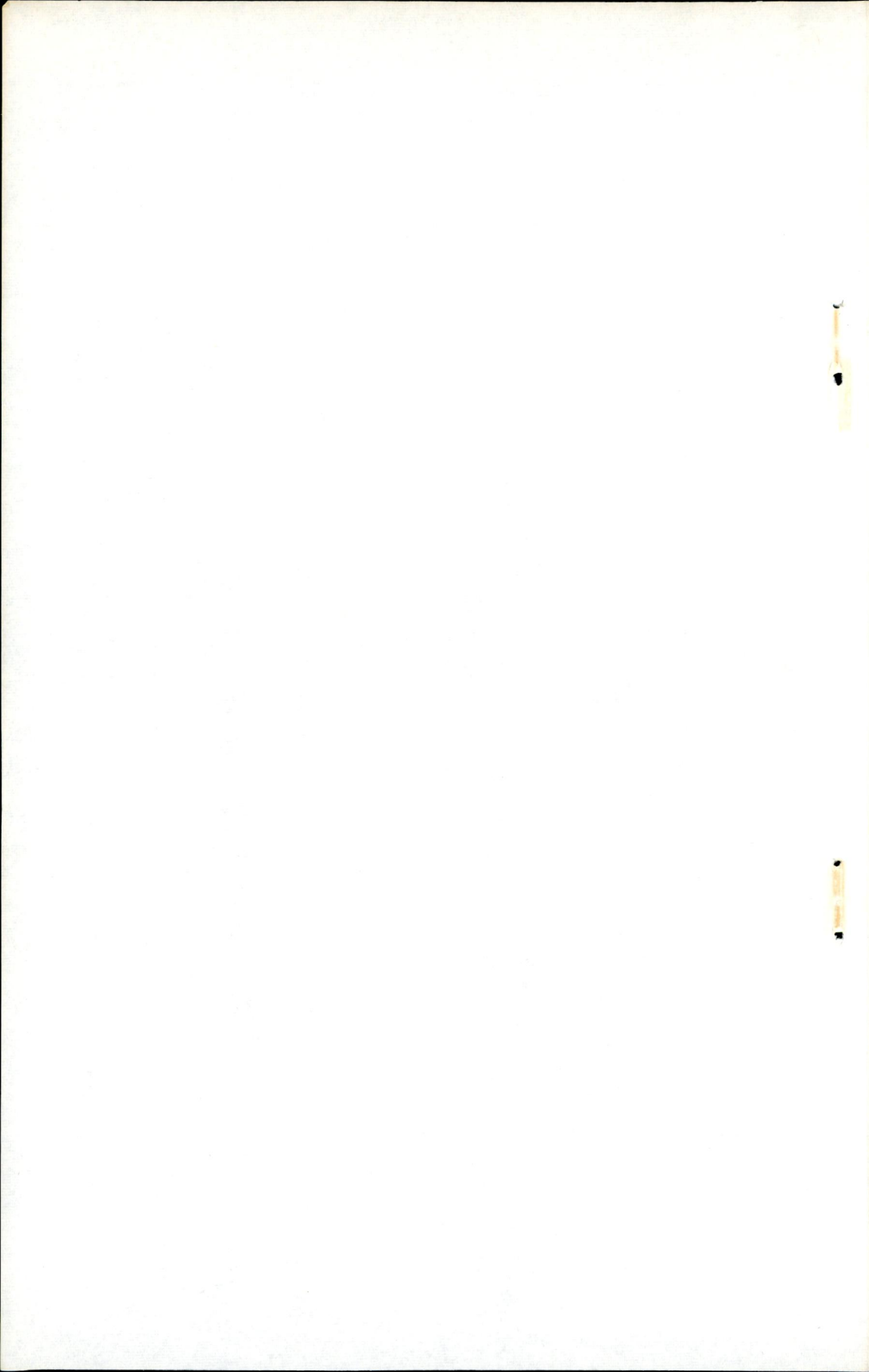
