EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to provide that officers of the Public Service, the Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission, the Departments of Main Roads, Railways, Government Transport and Motor Transport, and members of the Police Force be entitled to take long service leave after ten years service in lieu of fifteen years service as at present. The leave which may be so taken is two months on full pay or four months on half pay for ten years service and for service after ten years and before fifteen years a further proportionate amount on full pay or half pay calculated on the basis of one month or two months respectively for five years service.
