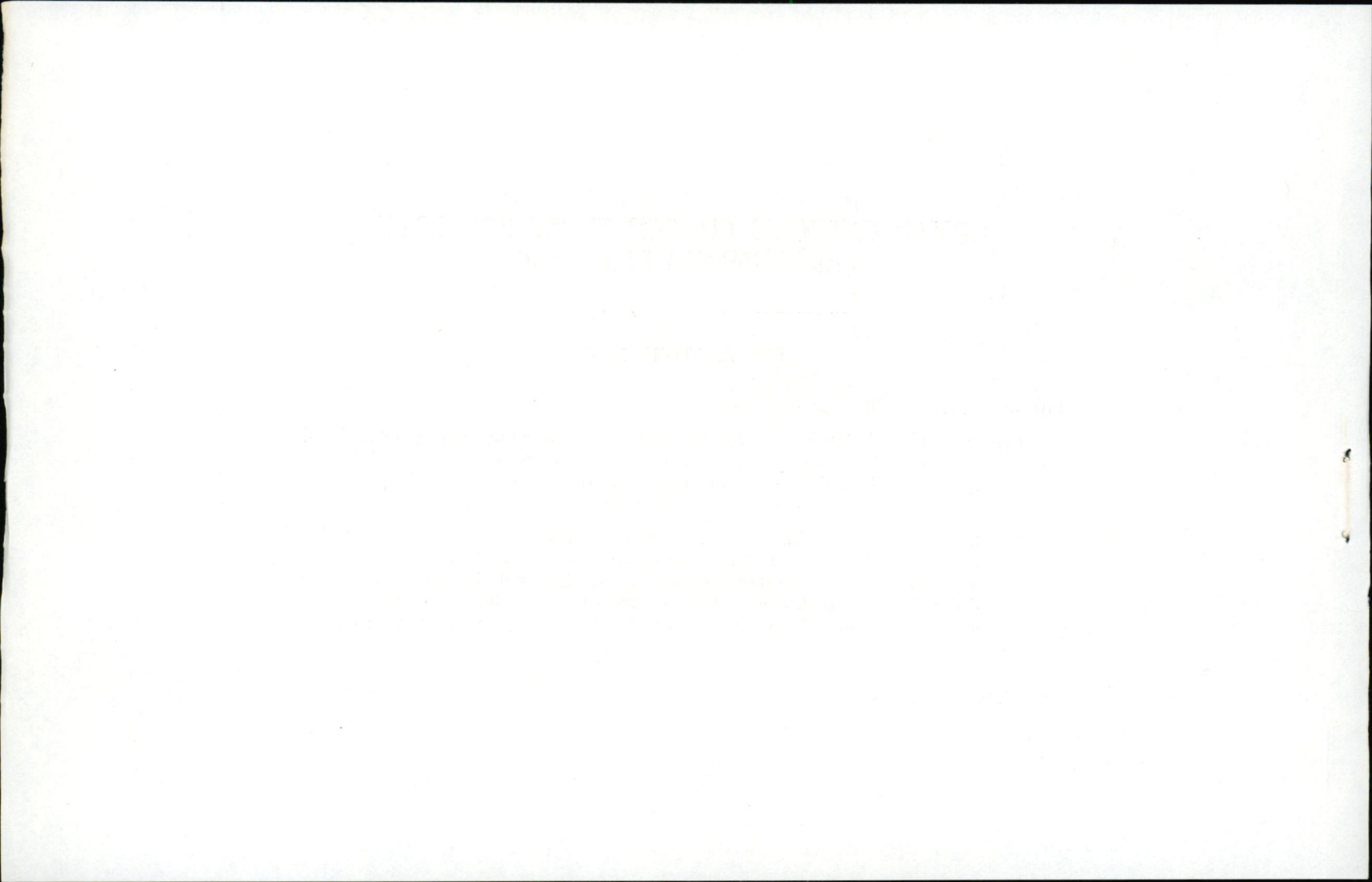

ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH TRUST PROPERTY (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to provide that titles to certain reserved or dedicated lands granted by the Crown to the Roman Catholic Church in New South Wales shall be valid notwithstanding the breach or non-performance of any condition, trust or proviso contained in any such grant; and
- (b) to provide that section 25 of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended, which authorises the revocation of reservations and dedications of Crown lands in certain circumstances, shall not, if the reservation or dedication was made before the date on which this Bill is assented to, apply to any such land which has been or may be granted to the Roman Catholic Church.

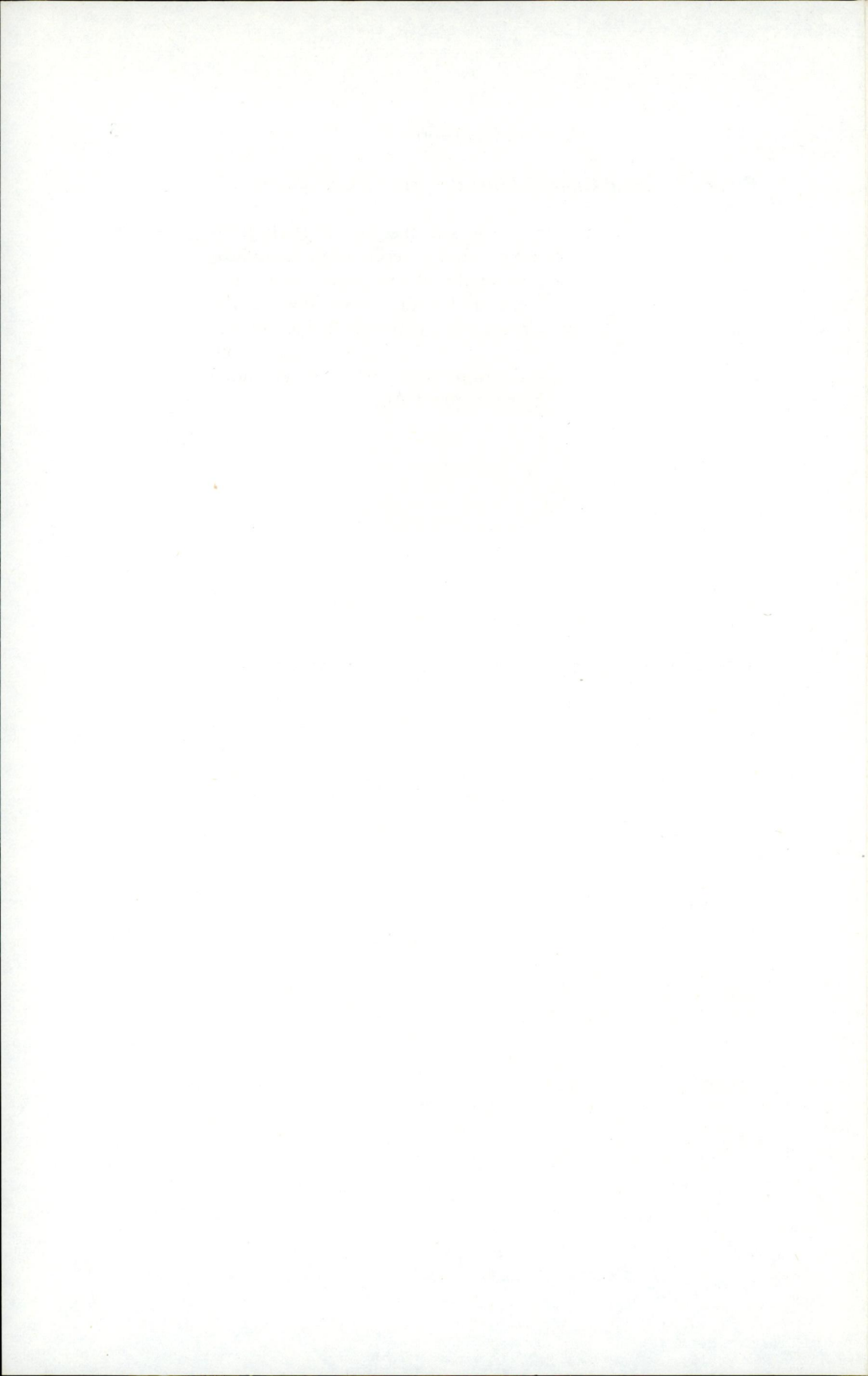
