## A BILL

To authorise the use of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church Cemetery at Woonona as a rest park or for certain other purposes; and for purposes connected therewith.

[MR. LEWIS;—18 *November*, 1965.]

---

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "St. Andrew's Presby- **Short title.**  
terian Church, Woonona, Cemetery Act, 1965".

2.

*St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, Woonona, Cemetery.*

2. In this Act, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise indicates or requires— Interpretation.

5       “the cemetery land” means such part of the land described in the Schedule to this Act as was, immediately before the commencement of this Act, owned by the Trustees and used as a cemetery;

      “the Trustees” means The Presbyterian Church (New South Wales) Property Trust.

10       3. It shall be lawful for the Trustees or such persons as may be authorised by them to use the cemetery land as a rest park or for such other purposes of the Presbyterian Church of Australia in the State of New South Wales as the Trustees may determine, notwithstanding— Use of cemetery land for other purposes.

15       (a) that, immediately before the commencement of this Act, the cemetery land comprised a cemetery; and

      (b) any trusts, conditions, encumbrances or dedications affecting the cemetery land immediately before the commencement of this Act.

20       4. (1) Before any use is made of the cemetery land pursuant to section three of this Act, the Trustees shall— Removal of human remains, monuments, etc.

25       (a) compile a register of the names of and other relevant information in respect of persons who are buried in or whose ashes have been placed in or on the cemetery land, so far as those names and that information can by reasonable diligence be obtained, and deposit and maintain the register at the offices of the Trustees at Sydney so as to be available for inspection by any interested person from time to time;

30       (b) furnish a certified copy of the register to the Minister;

(c) furnish a certified copy of the register to the Mitchell Library, Sydney, where it shall be maintained so as to be available for inspection by any interested person from time to time; and

5 (d) subject as hereinafter provided, cause such monuments and other surface structures on the cemetery land as the Trustees shall determine to be collected with due care and disposed of at the discretion of the Trustees.

10 (2) At least three months before any monuments or other surface structures are collected and disposed of under subsection one of this section, an advertisement of the intention to do so shall be inserted twice at an interval of not less than two weeks in a newspaper or newspapers published  
15 and circulating in the locality, and twice at an interval of not less than two weeks in a newspaper or newspapers published in Sydney and circulating widely throughout New South Wales.

(3) At any time after the appearance of the first  
20 advertisement referred to in subsection two of this section and before the expiration of three months from the appearance of the last of those advertisements, the representatives or any persons claiming to be the representatives of any person who is buried in the cemetery land or whose ashes have been  
25 placed in or on that land may, at their own expense, and with the permission of the Trustees, remove any monument or other surface structure that is upon the cemetery land and relates to that person, and may, at their own expense, and with the permission of the Director-General of Public Health,  
30 remove to such cemetery as they desire, the remains of that person.

(4) The Trustees shall as soon as practicable after the monuments and other surface structures are collected under subsection one of this section erect in a suitable position  
35 on the cemetery land a substantial monument indicating the sacred nature of the area.

5. No compensation shall be payable to any person in respect of the performance of any act authorised by this Act. No compensation payable.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

- (a) to enable The Presbyterian Church (New South Wales) Property Trust to remove monuments and other surface structures from St. Andrew's Presbyterian Cemetery at Woonona ;
- (b) to enable the land to be used as a rest park or for certain other purposes ;  
and
- (c) to make other provisions consequential upon and ancillary to the foregoing.

## A BILL

To authorise the use of St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church Cemetery at Woonona as a rest park or for certain other purposes; and for purposes connected therewith.

[MR. LEWIS;—18 November, 1965.]

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "St. Andrew's Presby- Short title,  
terian Church, Woonona, Cemetery Act, 1965".

2.

2. In this Act, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise indicates or requires— Interpretation.

5 “the cemetery land” means such part of the land described in the Schedule to this Act as was, immediately before the commencement of this Act, owned by the Trustees and used as a cemetery;

“the Trustees” means The Presbyterian Church (New South Wales) Property Trust.

3. It shall be lawful for the Trustees or such persons as Use of cemetery land for other purposes.  
10 may be authorised by them to use the cemetery land as a rest park or for such other purposes of the Presbyterian Church of Australia in the State of New South Wales as the Trustees may determine, notwithstanding—

15 (a) that, immediately before the commencement of this Act, the cemetery land comprised a cemetery; and

(b) any trusts, conditions, encumbrances or dedications affecting the cemetery land immediately before the commencement of this Act.

20 4. (1) Before any use is made of the cemetery land pursuant to section three of this Act, the Trustees shall— Removal of human remains, monuments, etc.

25 (a) compile a register of the names of and other relevant information in respect of persons who are buried in or whose ashes have been placed in or on the cemetery land, so far as those names and that information can by reasonable diligence be obtained, and deposit and maintain the register at the offices of the Trustees at Sydney so as to be available for inspection by any interested person from time to time;

30 (b) furnish a certified copy of the register to the Minister;

(c) furnish a certified copy of the register to the Mitchell Library, Sydney, where it shall be maintained so as to be available for inspection by any interested person from time to time; and

5 (d) subject as hereinafter provided, cause such monuments and other surface structures on the cemetery land as the Trustees shall determine to be collected with due care and disposed of at the discretion of the Trustees.

10 (2) At least three months before any monuments or other surface structures are collected and disposed of under subsection one of this section, an advertisement of the intention to do so shall be inserted twice at an interval of not less than two weeks in a newspaper or newspapers published  
15 and circulating in the locality, and twice at an interval of not less than two weeks in a newspaper or newspapers published in Sydney and circulating widely throughout New South Wales.

(3) At any time after the appearance of the first  
20 advertisement referred to in subsection two of this section and before the expiration of three months from the appearance of the last of those advertisements, the representatives or any persons claiming to be the representatives of any person who is buried in the cemetery land or whose ashes have been  
25 placed in or on that land may, at their own expense, and with the permission of the Trustees, remove any monument or other surface structure that is upon the cemetery land and relates to that person, and may, at their own expense, and with the permission of the Director-General of Public Health,  
30 remove to such cemetery as they desire, the remains of that person.

(4) The Trustees shall as soon as practicable after the monuments and other surface structures are collected under subsection one of this section erect in a suitable position  
35 on the cemetery land a substantial monument indicating the sacred nature of the area.

5. No compensation shall be payable to any person in respect of the performance of any act authorised by this Act. No compensation payable.
