An Act to make further provision with respect to the granting of permissive occupancies of certain land pursuant to the State Coal Mines Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts; for this purpose to amend that Act, as so amended; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "State Coal Mines (Amendment) Act, 1967".
