EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to provide that, to meet the cost of administration of the Swine Compensation Act, 1928, as amended, there shall in each year be paid out of the Swine Compensation Fund to the credit of the Consolidated Revenue Fund an amount equal to five per centum of the total sum paid to the Fund during the preceding year.
