SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1966.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to authorise the expenditure of a total amount of \$37,500,000 towards the construction of the works specified in the Schedule to the Sydney Opera House Act, 1960, as amended ;
- (b) to redescribe those works and to include in the works authorised the construction of a parking station ;
- (c) to make ancillary provisions.
