## TOONUMBAR DAM BILL, 1967

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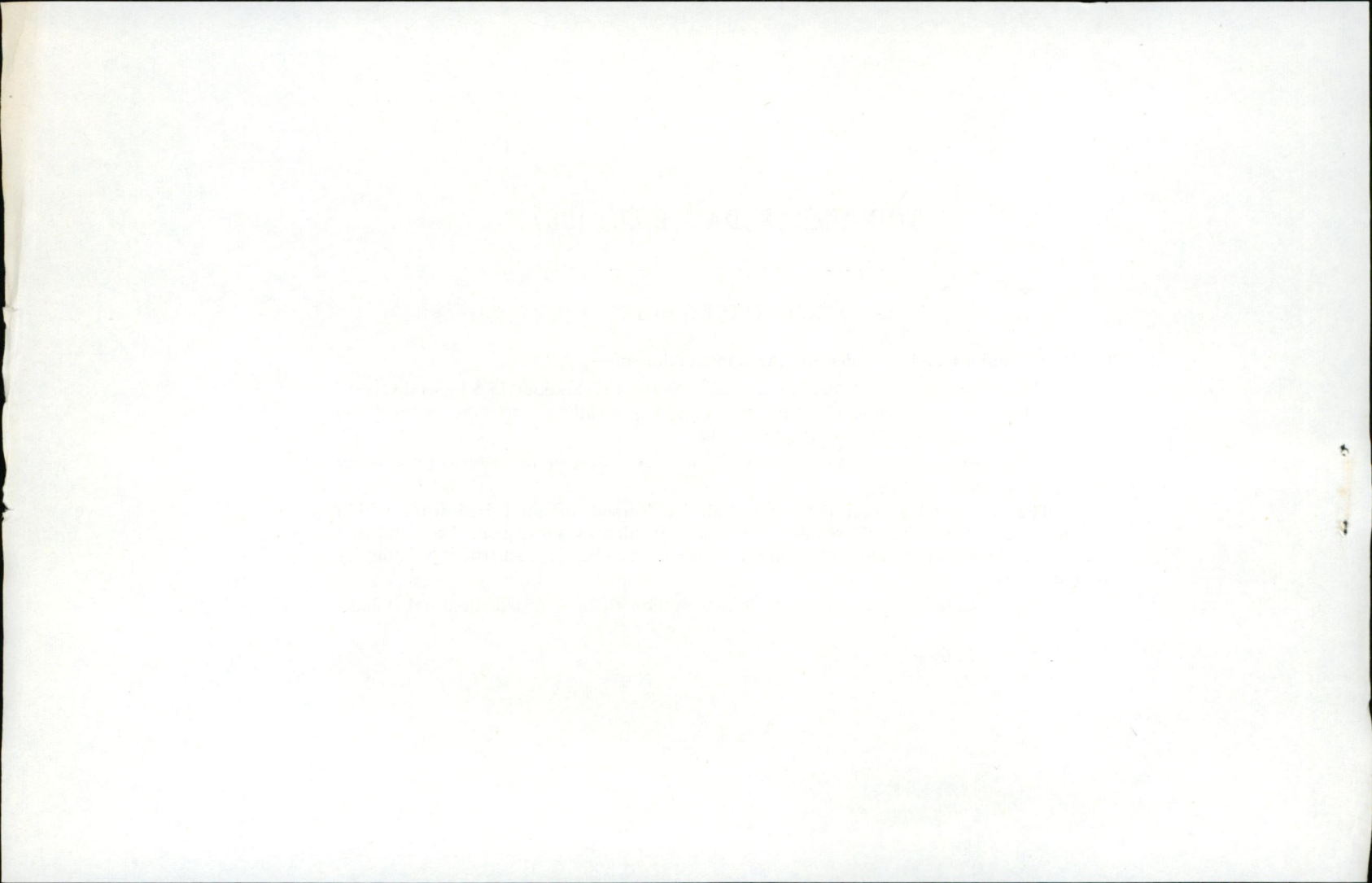
### EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE Bill sanctions and provides for the construction of—

- (a) an earth and rock-fill dam across the Iron Pot Creek about 15.5 miles upstream from its junction with Eden Creek of a height sufficient to store about 9,000 acre-feet of water for irrigation purposes ;
- (b) necessary spillway and outlet works for regulation of the discharge of water from the storage.

The Bill provides that the work shall be deemed an authorised work within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, and that The Water Conservation and Irrigation Commission shall be the Constructing Authority for the work.

The estimated cost of the work is five million three hundred thousand dollars.
