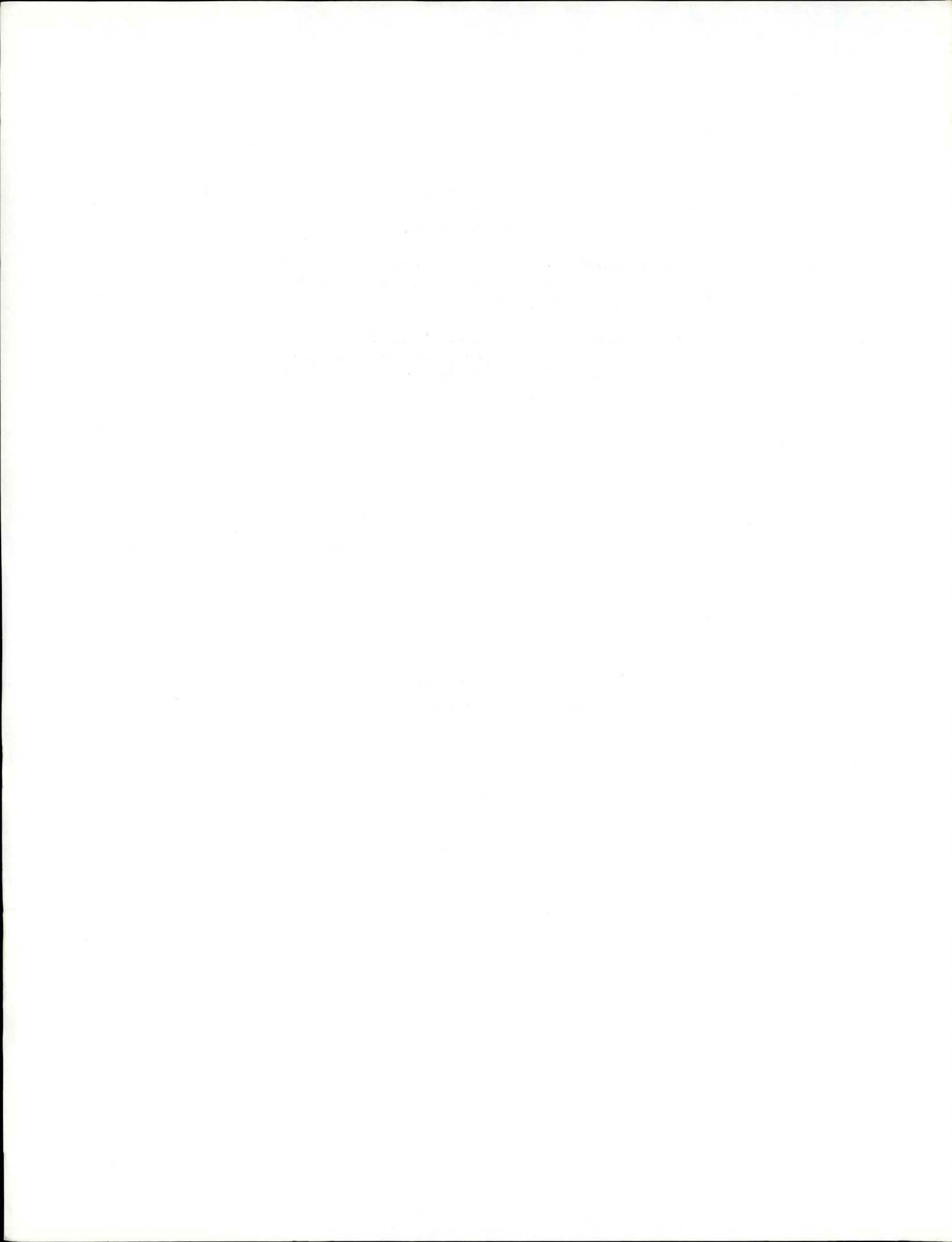

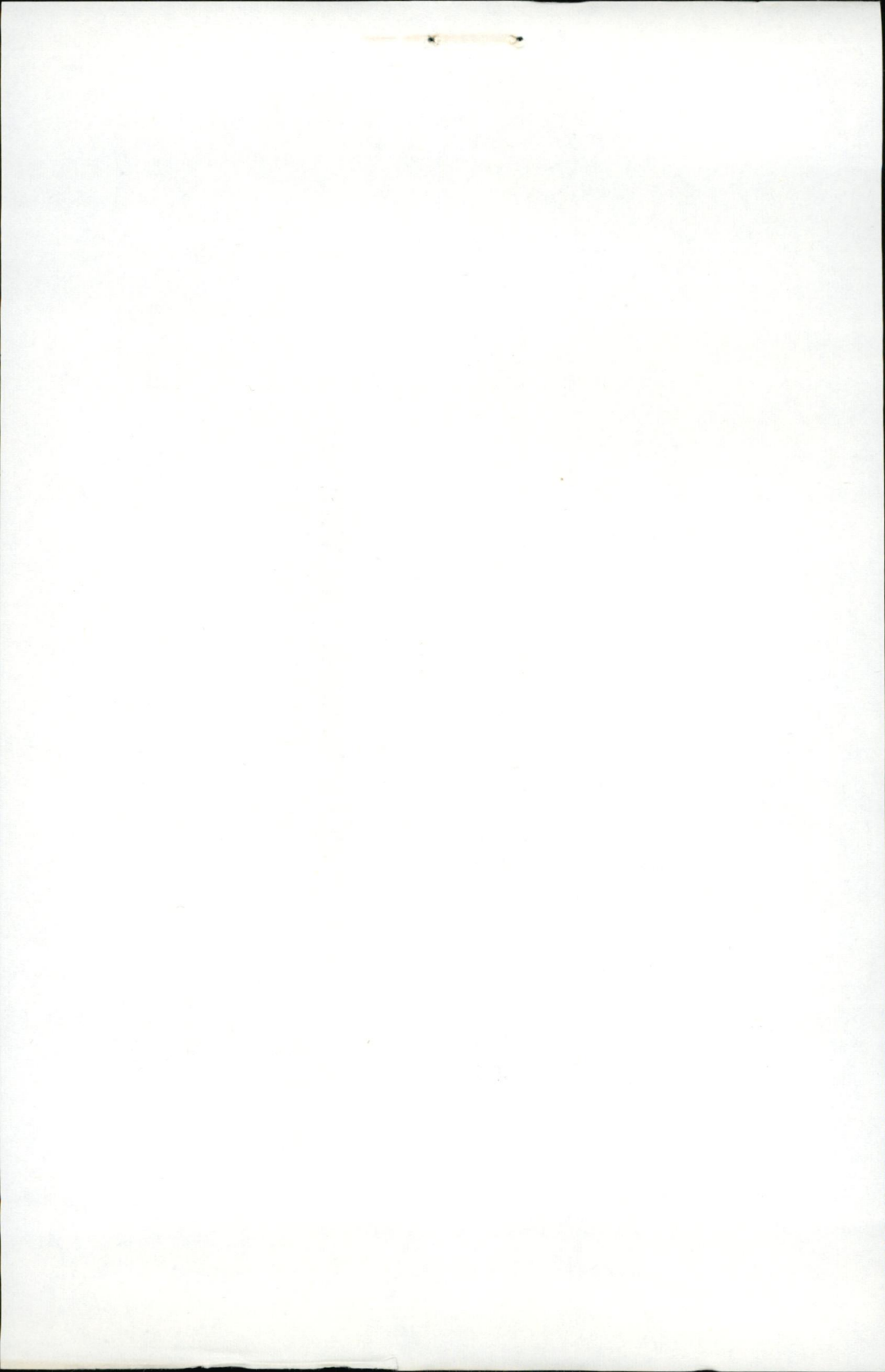

EXPLANATORY NOTE

THE object of this Bill is to increase the amount of commission to be deducted from investments on the totalizator and the payment to be made by clubs and the Totalizator Agency Board to the Treasurer by one-half per cent.
