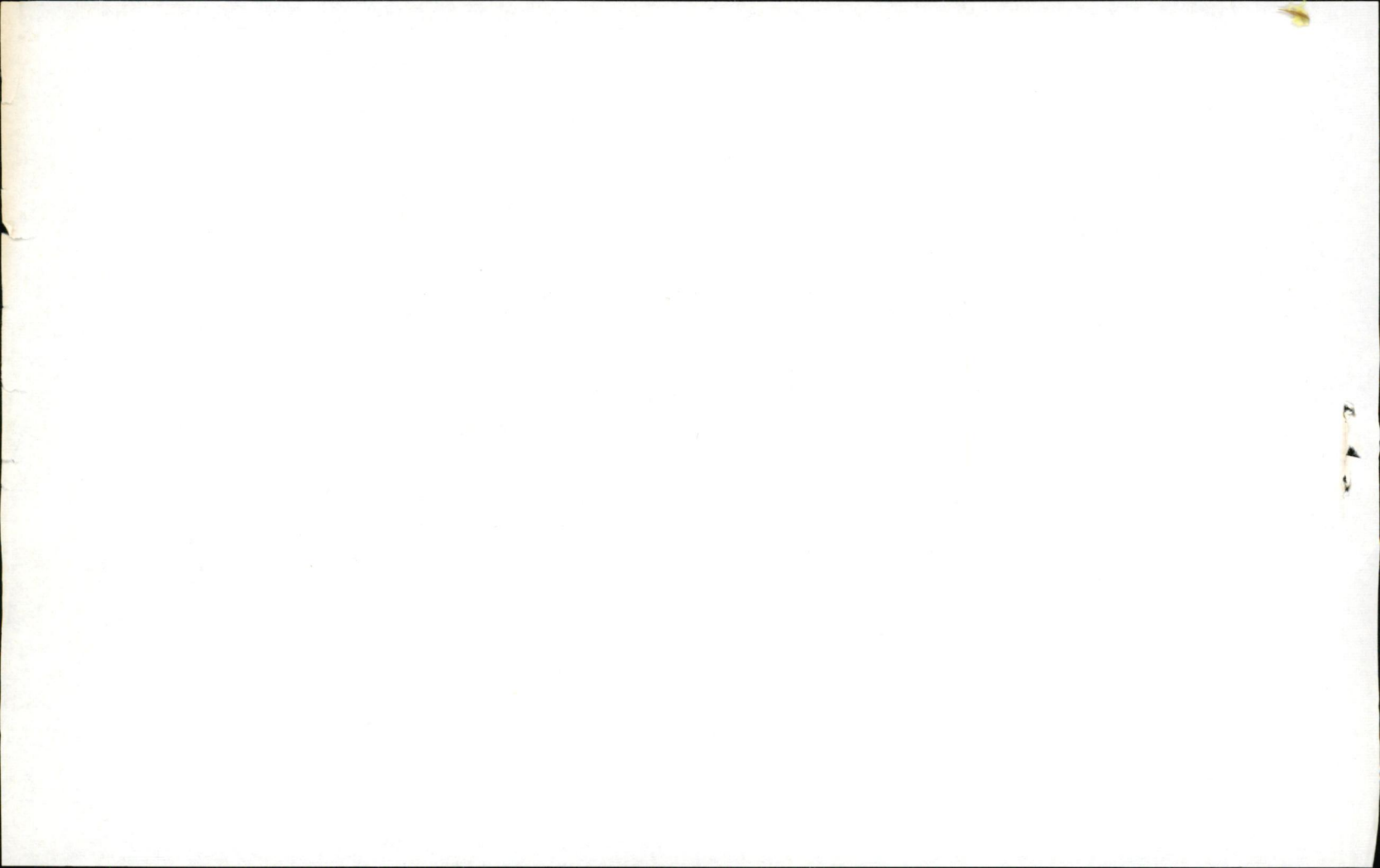
## **WEST SCHOLARSHIPS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1965.**

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE.**

THE objects of this Bill are—
