Subject to section thirty-four of the Audit Act and the Proviso. following proviso, expenditure shall not be incurred on any item, subdivision, division, or vote, shown on the Estimates of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in excess of the sum provided therefor by Parliament on such Estimates—provided that if the exigencies of the Public Service render it necessary, the Treasurer or person appointed by him may authorise the transfer of a specific amount from any item, subdivision, or division, other than for specific public works or an item under the division "Other Services," to any other item, subdivision, or division, within the same vote other

13. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act, 1968."

13. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act, 1968."
