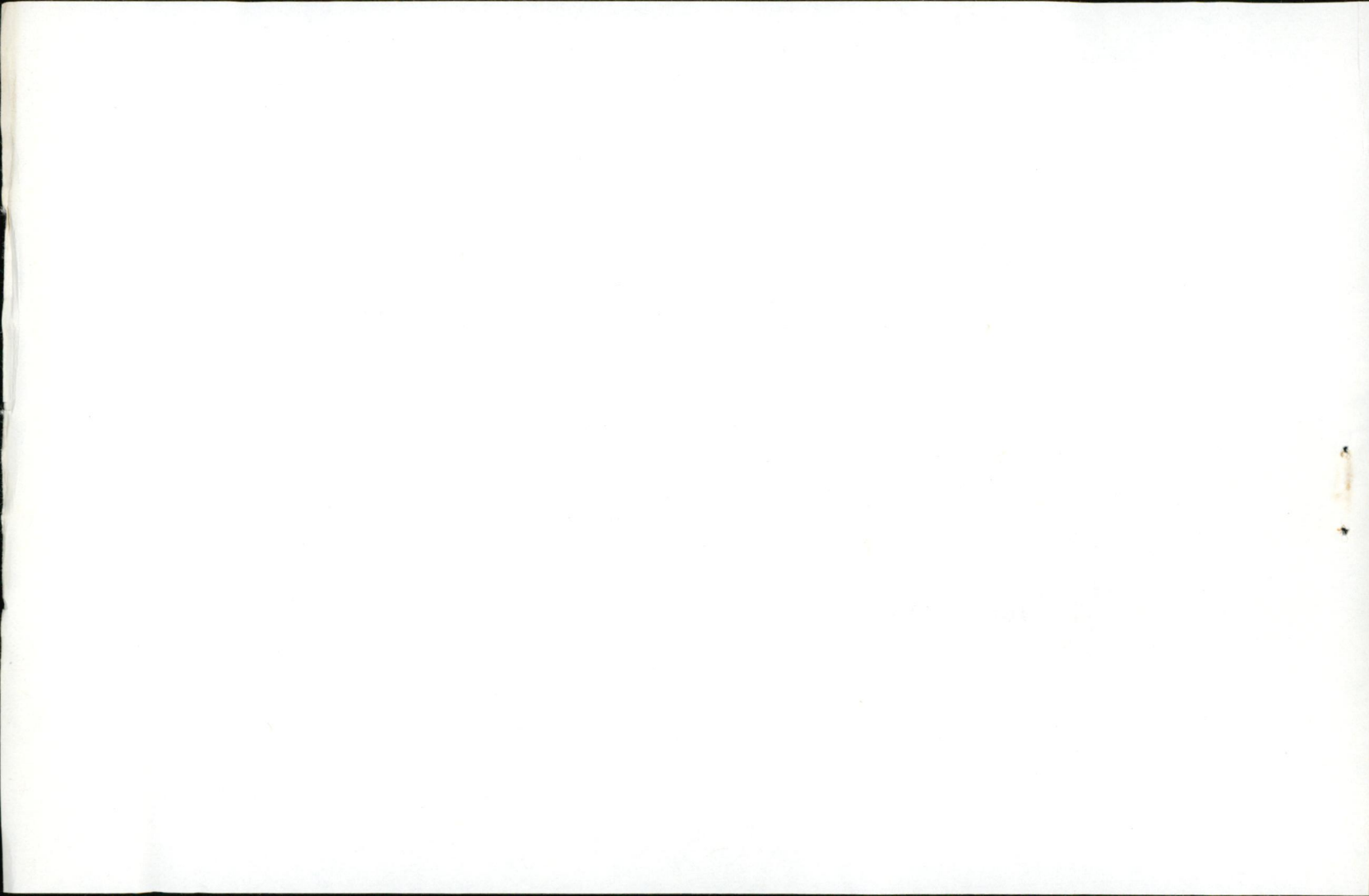

CATTLE COMPENSATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1968.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to amend the definition of “Chief of the Division of Animal Industry”; and
- (b) to extend from thirty days to sixty days the period during which an application may be made for compensation payable out of the Cattle Compensation Fund.
