Constitution and Standing (Part 1) (Continued)

(c) In addition to the provisions of the Constitution and Standing (Part 1) of the Society, the following provisions shall apply:

(i) The Society shall have the following powers:

(A) To borrow money and to incur liabilities on behalf of the Society;

(B) To acquire, hold, dispose of, and lease immovable property and to acquire, hold, dispose of, and lease movable property;

(C) To sue and be sued, and to prosecute and be prosecuted in any court of law.
